TWO INJURED DURING ELECTRICAL WORK AT HOTEL

Fire fighters responded to the Hyatt Regency Orange County shortly before 10:00 a.m. this morning for a reported structure fire. The first-arriving engine company found hotel guests evacuated after two electrical workers were electrocuted while working on power to a freight elevator. Crews confirmed there was no fire, and isolated the problem to the electrical work which initiated a fire alarm. The two workers were treated by fire department paramedics, and transported to the hospital for further evaluation. They were in stable condition at the time of the transport.

The first two floors were evacuated while fire fighters investigated, but guests were allowed to return a short while later. Power to the hotel was not compromised, and the Hyatt Regency remains open. Cal OSHA was contacted due to the work-related injuries.
