CHILD BITTEN BY DOG

Fire fighters responded to the 12000 block of Trask Avenue for a reported dog bite shortly before 11:30 a.m. today. The crew was met by parents with their pediatric son in front of the location. The child was lying in a dog bed in his home when one of two Doberman Pinschers reacted, and bit him. This resulted in serious wounds but not apparently life-threatening. The patient was treated by firefighter paramedics, and taken to Children's Hospital of Orange County for further care.

Garden Grove Animal Care Services was requested to respond. According to Animal Care Services supervisor, Mark Ladney, both dogs are on a 10 day quarantine and a Potentially Dangerous/Viscious Dog investigation has been initiated.
