	d. e.	chair displacements. (CFC 1028.10.1) Travel distance to an aisle access way shall not exceed 30' feet from any seat. (CFC 1028.10.1.2) Remove any obstructions preventing access to fire protection systems. (CFC 1028.1)			
В.	EXITS a. b. c.	Maintain exit door operations and exit hardware. (CFC 1008.1.10) Remove any exit obstruction(s). (CFC 1003.6) Remove any obstructions preventing visibility to illuminated exit signs or emergency lighting. (CFC 1028.1)			
C.	ELECTR a.	RICAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS If electrical wiring is placed in accessible areas, provide a wire guard to prevent a trip hazard. (CFC 605.5)			
D.	HOUSE a.	KEEPING Curtains, draperies, materials shall be fire resistive with State Fire Marshal Tag and shall be free from exits, exit pathways, exit signs and any ignition sources. (CFC 807.1)			
E.	INDOO a. b.	R DISPLAYS Fixtures and displaces shall be arranged where exits and aisles are unobstructed. (CFC 314.2) Liquid or gas fueled vehicles, boats or other motor crafts shall be only allowed if all are present: Batteries are disconnected, Fuel in tanks don't exceed one-quarter tank 5 gallons (whichever is least), fuel tanks and fill opening are closed, and they're not fueled or defueled inside the building.
