## **RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE DISPLACES THREE FAMILIES**

Fire fighters were dispatched to a residential structure fire at 9:42 a.m. today. The first-arriving engine reported heavy smoke and fire showing from a two-story apartment building. An attack on the fire was made, and a search for residents was also conducted. A primary search revealed there were no trapped victims. The fire was confined to the original unit involved on the first floor that resulted in extensive damage. The estimated damage to the structure is \$250,000 and \$50,000 to contents. There was no report of injury to residents or fire fighters.

Damage to the apartments prompted a response by the City building department. An inspection of the apartment found three units were determined to be uninhabitable. The Red Cross responded, and provided assistance to two families, with the third declining. The fire investigation is currently open and under investigation.
