Douglas Hitchcock addressed the Agency concerning his family's property on Harbor Boulevard, complaining that the City wants to give them an unsecured note for over \$2 million for their property in the area of Site B. Additionally, he commented that the Police Department should advise them when their loud helicopters are over their area and other noisy situations are occurring in that vicinity.
