#### STATUS REPORT ON SECTION 8 RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR APRIL AND MAY 2004 (F: H-117.2)

# PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-05 (F: H-34.1)

Staff report dated June 22, 2004, was introduced, presenting the Housing Authority Budget for Fiscal Year 2004-05, with both funding and expenditures totaling \$23,927,287, which reflects assistance to 2,338 families.

Chairman Dalton declared the public hearing opened and asked if anyone wished to address the Housing Authority on this matter.

In response to Commissioner Tran, staff noted that although the same number of families is being assisted, there is a decrease in the amount going to the landlords.

Commissioner Tran inquired as to how many families are on the waiting list. Staff noted that there are approximately 4,500. With only 10 families dropping out each month, the list is very slow to change.

In response to Chairman Dalton, staff noted that people who leave the city are still eligible.

There being no response from the audience, the public hearing was declared closed.
