Commissioner Stewart brought some information about the Elvis Festival and Karaoke contest that was put on by the Orange County Market Place but is being sold and will no longer be able to hold these events. It was suggested that Main Street could be the new home for these events. This will also be discussed at the Downtown Business Association Meeting.

6. MATTERS FROM STAFF

Update on Tree trimming: The trees in west parking lot have now been trimmed and the rotation for trimming is every other year.

Trash Enclosure Update: Staff has a meeting with a contractor to repair the gates. Then the interior can be pressure washed and/or replacement bins can be ordered by the merchant who has the contract with Republic Services. The tagging on the outside of the enclosures themselves need to be cleaned up as well.
