RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION

At 7:20 p.m., the meeting was reconvened in the Council Chamber with President Dalton and all Board members in attendance, and it was announced that the previously disclosed item was discussed and no others. Further, that the proposed settlement was accepted on a three to two vote, with Member Leyes and Member Rosen voting no, and the document will be available in the City Clerk's office for review after it has been prepared. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS - PUBLIC

Charles Mitchell addressed the Board, expressing concern about the sewer bond issue, noting the City should be paying for sewer improvements and maintenance on a "pay-as-you-go" basis. He also expressed concern that Sanitary District Advisory Commission agendas and minutes are not being provided in a timely manner and contain irregularities. (F: S-53.3) (XR: S-60.1) (XR: S-122.1)

Jon Wilmes addressed the Board asking for justification for excessive rise in the sewer maintenance fee for his triplex rental, noting that it went from \$11.40 to \$122.62. He indicated that this is forcing him to increase the rents on his property. Mayor Dalton indicated that staff will contact Mr. Wilmes. (F: S-53.3) (XR: S-60.1)
