4.a. Changes to the District Code (Informational)

4.b. Update on Brookhurst Triangle

Mr. Holmon gave an update on the illegal dumping that took place on the property. A small amount of the soil was found to be contaminated. The city contracted with Ocean Blue to remove and process the soil it will be shipped out of state.

Matters from the Commission

Chair Brietigam:

- Lack of vegetation and irrigation along Lampson Avenue from Manley (Garden Grove border) to Valley View.
- Information on donations to community groups; it was noted to contact Ann Eifert directly at 714.741.5554.

Commissioner Mitchell:

- FOG green caps have a misspelling on them.
- Can a notice be put in the Garden Grove Journal telling the public that old prescriptions can be taken in at the police department?
- Using reclaimed water for irrigation along Lampson Avenue \sim staff noted there is no infrastructure to support reclaimed water.

Commissioner Arbgast:

- Spill at Mae's Café at the intersection of Magnolia and Trask. Staff noted that there was a 60-gallon spill and that it was handled expeditiously.
- Large items are being left in the parkway; does the City actively police areas for large items being left in the parkways? Staff noted that you can call Rosemarie Jacot directly to report any debris and/or large items that have been left in the right-of-way and a work order will be processed to have the items or debris removed. Staff will perform a query on the number of work orders performed for this service and report back at the next meeting.
