The BSCC recognized the importance of local agencies being able to best identify their own needs with regards to the use of resources, and approved the formula. Funding for Local Assistance was reauthorized in the Budget Act of 2015. For fiscal year 2015-16, the Budget Act has appropriated approximately \$20 million for city police departments. Orange County agencies were allocated a total of approximately \$1.19 million, and Garden Grove's allocation is \$117,791.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Using BSCC money, in the amount of \$117,791, to help fund the Police Department's front-line services creates no burden on the City's General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Approve the acceptance of Local Assistance Law Enforcement Funds from the California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) in the amount of \$117,791; and
- Authorize the allocation of these funds to the Police Department for front-line law enforcement services.
