OBJECTIVE

To receive Garden Grove Sanitary District Board approval of Cooperative Agreement No. C-7-1176 with the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) for the construction, operation and maintenance of a sewer lift station near Garden Grove Boulevard and Partridge Street.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

As part of the SR-22 improvements, OCTA had requested and the District agreed to construct, operate, and maintain a sewer lift station near Garden Grove Boulevard and Partridge Street. The District will act as lead agency for the Thunderbird Lift Station and be reimbursed \$824,600 for final design, construction, and construction management. Additionally, a lump sum of \$800,000 will be released to the District for the operation and maintenance costs of the project. No invoices for reimbursement can be processed until the agreement is fully executed.

A summary of the cost estimate for OCTA is provided below:
