#### OBJECTIVE

For the City Council to proclaim the week of May 18–24, 2008, as National Public Works Week in the City of Garden Grove.

#### COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION


Ensure timely, accurate, and useful communication of information on issues affecting the community by increasing the breadth of communication between the City and the community.
