OBJECTIVE

To award a contract for the rehabilitation of Harbor Boulevard from Garden Grove Boulevard to Chapman Avenue

BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION

The project consists of the removal and replacement of existing failed pavement areas, milling of existing pavement, crack sealing and pavement preparation along with the construction of asphalt concrete inlays with pavement fabric. The proposed improvements also include the removal and replacement of concrete median curb, colored concrete, curb and gutter, sidewalk and wheel chair ramps. The project will require traffic control, replacement of traffic striping, and replacement of traffic signal loops. The proposed street rehabilitation project will significantly improve safety, ride and appearance of Harbor Boulevard as well as enhance and maximize their longevity.

ANALYSIS

Eleven (11) qualified bids were received and opened in the City Clerk's office at 10:00 a.m. on November 24, 2009, pursuant to Sections 20160-20175-1 of the California Public Contract Code (PCC), as required by section 22032 (c) of the PCC and Section 2.50.100 and 2.52.010 of the Municipal Code as defined in the City's Purchasing Manual. The lowest qualified bidder is All American Asphalt, with a total bid of \$ 919,000. This bid is within the current project budget.

The licenses and references of the contractor have been reviewed and verified by staff, and all other documentation is in order. The anticipated contract schedule is as follows:

<i>Begin construction (estimated)</i>	<i>February 22, 2010</i>
<i>Complete construction (estimated)</i>	<i>June 30, 2010</i>

COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

This project is consistent with the community vision for maintaining and enhancing, the City's infrastructure assets to maximize their value, longevity, and usefulness for the community.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The recommended action will not impact the general fund. This improvement is included in the 2009-10 Capital Improvement Budget and is funded by Gas Tax (fund 061), Measure "M" local (fund 421) and Federal Stimulus Funds.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council:
