 RECOMMENDATION TO AWARD CONTRACT

OBJECTIVE

To award a contract for the construction of the Brookhurst Street/Garden Grove Boulevard Intersection Improvements, Project No. 7265.

BACKGROUND

Brookhurst Street is a heavily traveled arterial that provides access to motorists traveling to freeways and places of employment. The Brookhurst Street/ Garden Grove Boulevard intersection is not operating efficiently during peak hour traffic due to high traffic volume. The traffic at the intersection worsens because the limited street width precludes the City from providing a right turn lane on northbound Brookhurst.

DISCUSSION

The proposed project consists of adding a right turn lane on northbound Brookhurst Street from its intersection with Emerson Avenue to Garden Grove Boulevard. Construction of the improvements will involve the removal and relocation of existing curb, gutter, sidewalk, curb return, pull boxes, utilities, and will also involve asphalt paving, traffic signal modification, and signing and striping.

Twelve (12) qualified bids were received and opened in the City Clerk's office at 11:00 a.m. on April 29, 2010. The lowest qualified bidder is R.J. Noble Company, with a total bid of \$390,255.50. This bid is within the current project budget. The licenses and references of the contractor have been reviewed and verified by staff, and all other documentation is in order. The anticipated contract schedule is as follows:

<i>Award contract</i>	<i>June 8, 2010</i>
<i>Begin construction</i>	<i>September 7, 2011</i>
<i>Complete construction</i>	<i>April 30, 2011</i>

The 15-month delay in the start of construction is due to relocation of challenging overhead utilities such as electrical, telephone, and cable TV.


FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the general fund for the Brookhurst Street/Garden Grove Boulevard Intersection Improvements. The construction cost of \$390,255.50 will be funded through Measure M Turn-Back (421) and Measure M CTFP grant funding (423).

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Award the contract to R.J. Noble Company, for \$390,255.50.
- Authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
