Agenda Item 4-b. Disabled Person On-Street Parking Space, 6191 Cerulean Avenue September 7, 2010

OBJECTIVE

To consider a request to install a disabled person on-street parking space in front of 6191 Cerulean Avenue.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The City has received a request from Mrs. Jane Lum to install a disabled person on-street parking space in front of her residence. Mrs. Lum has submitted the application on behalf of her husband. In submitting the application, Mrs. Lum stated the space would allow for OCTA's ACCESS bus to drop off and pick up her husband who is wheel chair bound. ACCESS is OCTA's shared-ride service for people who are unable to use the regular, fixed-route bus service because of functional limitations caused by a disability. Mr. Lum uses the ACCESS bus daily for doctor appointments.

In order for a disabled person on-street parking space to be installed in a residential area, four conditions must exist. After a field review and a conversation with Mrs. Lum, staff has determined that the criteria have been satisfied.

RECOMMENDATION

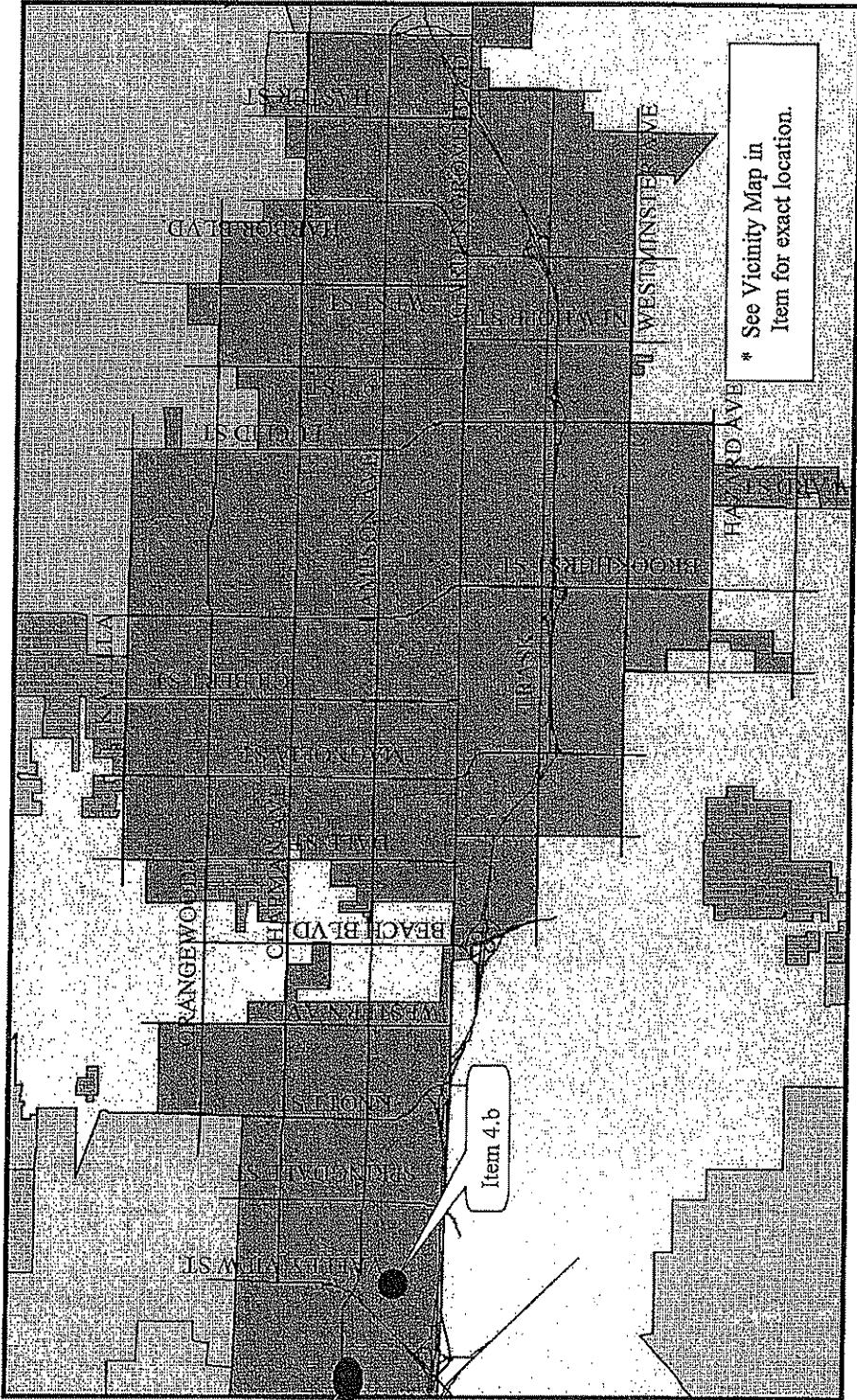
It is recommended that the Traffic Commission receive public input and approve staff's recommendation to install a disabled person on-street parking space in front of 6191 Cerulean Avenue.

GENERAL LOCATION MAP

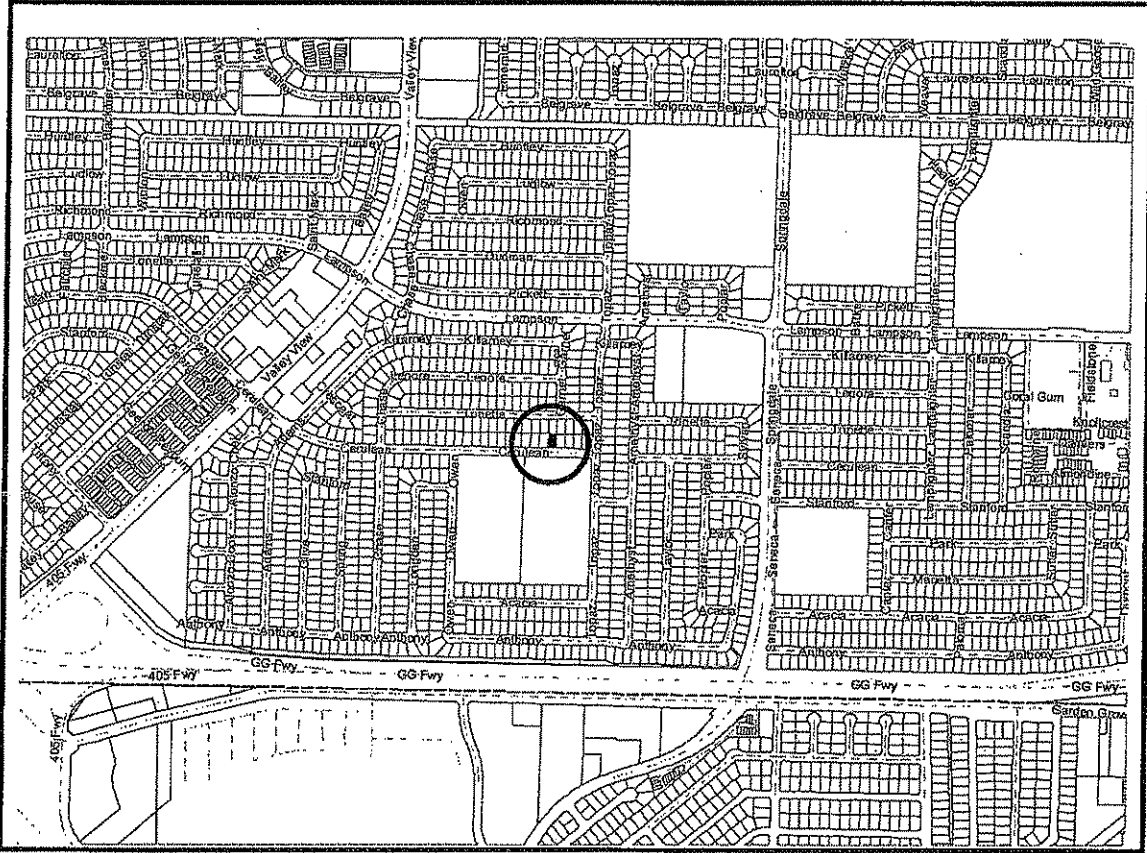
