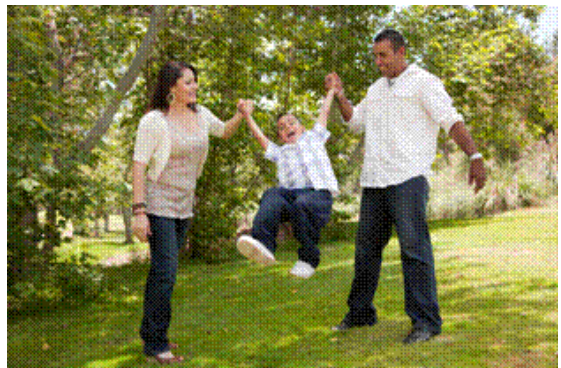
Join us for an interactive and supportive series to learn and strengthen practical, proven and positive parenting skills.

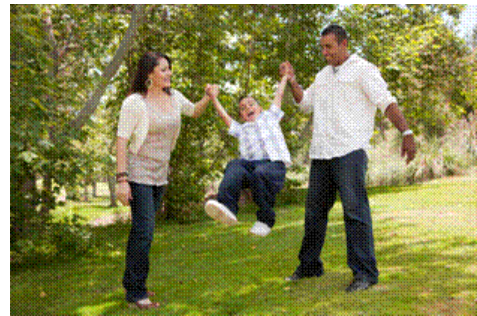
