

# **2012 Vendor Policy**Summer Concert Series

July12 through August 16 Every Thursday, 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Eastgate Park

## **For-Profit Vendors**

- Subject to a fee of \$600 for all six (6) concerts; and
- A maximum of six (6) food vendors will be allowed at each concert; and
- Vendors are limited to sales of up to two non-competing foods, at the discretion of the Concert Committee; and
- Must show proof of a Garden Grove business license; and
- Must adhere to all applicable City, County, State and Federal Regulations; and
- Only one six (6) foot table per vendor, to be supplied by vendor; and
- Must submit a completed vendor contract, check payable to the GGCF, and proof of insurance no later than, **Friday**, **June 1**, **2012**; and
- If vendor is selling food, they must comply with all Orange County Health Care Agency's requirements by **Friday**, **June 29**, **2012**.

## **Non-Profit Groups**

- No more than two (2) non-profit groups per concert; and
- Groups will only be allowed to participate in two (2) concerts per series; and
- Only one six (6) foot table per group, to be supplied by non-profit; and
- Must adhere to all applicable City, County, State and Federal Regulations; and
- The Committee will allow returning groups to participate in more than two (2) concerts if there is space available; and
- Must submit a completed non-profit application no later than, Friday, June 15, 2012; and
- If group is selling food, they must comply with all Orange County Health Care Agency's requirements by **Friday**, **June 29**, **2012**.

#### **Exceptions**

GGCF sponsors and the City of Garden Grove will not be subject to the fee and concert participation limitation.

# **Termination Clause**

The Garden Grove Community Foundation and the City of Garden Grove have the right to terminate this Agreement, without cause, by giving seven (7) days written notice of termination. In addition, all groups (for-profit and non-profit) shall adhere to any and all guidelines set forth by the Garden Grove Community Foundation, the City of Garden Grove, and the County of Orange Health Care Agency. Any violations, that adversely affect the intended nature of the Summer Concert Series, will result in immediate termination of this contract without reimbursement to the group.

# All participants (both for-profit vendors and non-profit groups)

The Committee reserves the right at its sole discretion to determine and approve which groups/businesses can participate in the concerts, as well as the items/goods to be sold during the concerts, in order to prevent competition among vendors for sales of similar goods.
