NOTICE OF NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING

The City of Garden Grove will hold a Neighborhood Meeting for the Water Transmission Main – Lampson Pump Station to West Garden Grove Pump Station

DATE/TIME: **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 24, 2011 AT 7:00 P.M.**

MEETING

LOCATION: **11300 STANFORD AVENUE, COMMUNITY MEETING CENTER, GARDEN GROVE**

DISCUSSION: **THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE (CITY) IS SCHEDULED TO CONSTRUCT A NEW WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN FROM ITS LAMPSON PUMP STATION TO ITS WEST GARDEN GROVE PUMP STATION. CONSTRUCTION IS ANTICIPATED TO BEGIN IN FEBRUARY 2012. THE PROJECT IS PRESENTLY UNDER DESIGN BY A CONSULTING FIRM, CIVILTEC, WHO'S CONTRACT WAS APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AT THEIR MAY 10, 2011 CITY COUNCIL MEETING.**

THE PROJECT BEGINNING POINT IS IN LAMPSON AVENUE, APPROXIMATELY 1,000 FEET WEST OF NINTH STREET, WHERE A TAP WILL BE MADE INTO AN EXISTING 18-INCH STEEL MAIN. A 16-INCH DIAMETER MAIN IS TO BE INSTALLED ALONG LAMPSON AVENUE TO EUCLID AVENUE AND NORTH ALONG EUCLID AVENUE TO ALLEN DRIVE. THE MAIN WILL CONTINUE WESTERLY ALONG ALLEN DRIVE TO NUTWOOD STREET, AND CONTINUES NORTHERLY ALONG NUTWOOD STREET TO CHAPMAN AVENUE, WHERE THE MAIN CONTINUES WESTERLY ALONG CHAPMAN AVENUE TO KNOTT STREET. AT THAT LOCATION, THE WATER MAIN WILL BE CONVEYED THROUGH THE TOP OF THE WALL OF THE EXISTING WEST GARDEN GROVE RESERVOIR, LOCATED AT 7001 CHAPMAN AVENUE.

THE PURPOSE OF THE WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN IS TO ELIMINATE THE NEED TO CONSTRUCT A WELL IN WEST GARDEN GROVE, AND TO CREATE BETTER EFFICIENCY IN THE WATER SYSTEM THAT WILL MAXIMIZE UTILIZATION OF EXISTING RESERVOIR STORAGE FACILITIES IN EAST GARDEN GROVE. ALSO, THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE TRANSMISSION MAIN IS CONSIDERABLY LESS THAN MAINTAINING A WELL OVER A LONG-TERM PERIOD.
