



Holiday Trash and Recycling of Turkey Grease, Tree and Other

How do I dispose of leftover grease from frying my turkey?

Residents may dispose of up to 15-gallons of turkey grease free-of-charge at the County of Orange Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center located at 1071 N. Blue Gum Street Anaheim, CA

How can I keep pipes flowing free during the holidays?

Clean greasy pots and pans first by wiping them with newspaper or paper towels before washing. Place the greasy newspaper or paper towels in your trash container.

How can I keep my pipes flowing free during the holidays?

Do NOT wash Fats, Oils & Grease (FOG) down the drain.

Pour small amounts of used cooking oil (once it has cooled) into a container with paper towels, coffee grounds, or other absorbent material. Close the container and place in the trash.

How can I recycle my holiday tree?

Place your tree in your yard waste container or on the ground next to your collection containers during the two weeks following Christmas Day. A FREE collection will be provided **Dec. 26 – Jan. 7**

Limit 1 per resident

Have trees out by 7 a.m.

Remove stand and all decorations.

Do not put trees in a plastic bag.

All trees larger than six-feet must be cut-in-half.

Flocked trees are not recyclable, and therefore, are not eligible for the free collection.

Flocked trees may be disposed of in the regular trash container or by scheduling a bulky item pickup.

Multi-Family with Bin Service - Large volume multi-family customers with bin service are encouraged to rent a roll-off to recycle holiday trees. We are offering a discounted rate for green waste roll-offs during the months of December and January - \$230 per load, up to 6 tons, over 6 tons \$43.04. Two-week maximum rental. Bin is for green waste only; if the container is found to contain trash the rate will be adjusted to the regular disposal rates. Commercial customers are not eligible for this discounted rate. Smaller complexes may



instruct residents to place trees off to the side of the bin for collection, NOT in front or in the bin. (same regulations as single-family)

Drop-Off at Our Anaheim Facility – (January 8 - 31) –1131 N. Blue Gum Anaheim, CA
We will offer FREE drop-off at our facility, to accommodate residents in our service cities that may have missed their tree collection opportunity. Residents may drop-off their tree at the green waste roll-off located in the north/east employee parking lot at Blue Gum and La Palma, entrance off White Star. Limit one tree per customer, not for commercial use. Hours: 7 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Will my trash collection be delayed during the holidays?

YES – Trash collection will be delayed by one day, if your collection falls on, or after one of the following holidays:

Thanksgiving Day – Nov. 22

Christmas Day – Dec. 25

New Year' Day – Jan. 1

Can my holiday waste be recycled?

YES - the following holiday waste is recyclable and should be placed in your recycle container:

Wrapping Paper

Gift Boxes

Shipping Boxes
