Safety Transportation Guidelines

- Bring the items in a sturdy box preferably in their original container, labeled and closed or with a lid.
- Max. 15 gallons or 125 pounds total waste per vehicle, per trip.
- Cannot accept containers larger than 5 gallons.
- Do not combine different types of waste.
- · Do not mix oil-base paint with latex paint.
- · Empty containers without lids can be discarded in trash.

Household hazardous waste only. Business waste not accepted.
