FIRE - Dryer Fire

Responded as part of a structure assignment to a single family residence on a report of a garage / clothes dryer fire. Upon arrival, GE2 found light smoke coming from the garage & the occupants standing in the front yard. GE2 investigated while holding the assignment.

GE2's firefighter found a bedroom at the back of the garage that was attached to a laundry room. The bedroom was charged with smoke nearly to the floor with high temperatures. GE2 pulled a hoseline, established Orangewood IC, assigned GE5 to Fire Attack, assigned CT64 to Ventilation group and released AE11. GE5 handled utilities & confirmed a primary all clear.

The fire was knocked down & smoke was removed via horizontal ventilation. Ceilings & walls in the laundry room were opened to check for extension. The dryer was removed to the back yard and the fire was confirmed to be out with a thermal imaging camera.

Command was dissolved & units were released. A property release form was explained to & understood by the occupant. Power to the unaffected portion of the residence was restored.
