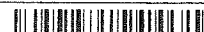

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TERM LIMITS OF TWO
CONSECUTIVE FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE OFFICE
OF COUNCILMEMBER AND FOUR CONSECUTIVE
TWO-YEAR TERMS FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Code Amendment.

Garden Grove Municipal Code Section 2.04.020, entitled "Term Limits," is hereby added to Title 2, "Administration and Personnel," to read as follows:

Section 2.04.020. Term Limits.

(a) Purpose and Intent

The State Legislature has amended Government Code section 36502 to provide that cities may enact term limits for councilmembers, subject to a vote of the people. The City Council hereby finds that it would be sound public policy to establish term limits with respect to the office of mayor and councilmembers, pursuant to Government Code section 36502.

(b) Establishment of Term Limits

(1) Office of Mayor

No person shall serve more than four (4) consecutive two-year terms as mayor. No person who has been appointed to the office of mayor for more than one year of an unexpired term shall be eligible for more than three (3) subsequent terms.

(2) Councilmember

No person shall serve more than two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms as councilmember. No person who has been appointed to the office of councilmember for more than two (2) years of an unexpired term shall be eligible for more than one additional four (4) year term.

(3) Subsequent Terms.

A person may be elected to the office of Mayor or Councilmember after completing consecutive terms in that office if that person has not occupied that office for one full term prior to running for the office.

(4) Exception.

The term limit restrictions set forth herein shall not be applicable to any person having completed consecutive terms in the office of councilmember, desiring to be elected to the office of mayor, and vice-versa.

(c) Prospective Application

Pursuant to Government Code section 36502(b), this term limit provision shall apply prospectively only.

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS BY CITY ATTORNEY
MEASURE Z

This measure would create consecutive term limits for both the office of Mayor and Councilmember, for the first time in the City of Garden Grove.

The measure would add Municipal Code section 2.04.020 to the City's Municipal Code to restrict a person from holding more than four (4) consecutive two (2) year terms in the office of Mayor, and two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms in the office of Councilmember.

Under the measure, a person would be allowed to cross over from one office to the other, even if that person has served the maximum number of terms permitted. For example, if a person served two consecutive terms as Councilmember, the person could then seek election for the office of Mayor.

In addition, the measure does not prohibit running for the same office after serving the maximum number of terms, once the person has sat out of this office for a full term.

A recent change to state law [Government Code section 36502(b)], now permits general law cities to enact term limit regulations, subject to a vote of the people. Pursuant to this state law change, the Garden Grove City Council has now chosen to place this term limit measure before the voters of the City of Garden Grove.

ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF MEASURE Z

Term Limits restore integrity and responsibility to local government. Term limits reinvigorate government with new blood and new ideas. Real citizen leaders will challenge the bureaucracy and will remember that taxpayers are the real bosses of government.

When Councilman Mark Leyes proposed this term limit ordinance, Leyes, Mayor Bruce Broadwater, Councilman Ho Chung and Councilman Tony Ingegneri approved it so the voters could enact term limits on City Council and Mayor. We say it's long overdue and ask you to support Measure Z.

IF ONLY WE HAD TERM LIMITS IN
ORANGE COUNTY BEFORE NOW!

With term limits on the County Treasurer, he would have been long gone and never would have gambled tax money, forcing the county into bankruptcy.

No member of the Orange County Board of Supervisors would have been able to sit for over 15 years, out of touch with the people who elected them and controlled by county bureaucrats. RESOLUTION NO. 7860-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE, RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 26, 1996, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the city of Garden Grove, California, on Tuesday, March 26, 1996, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 7830-96 adopted November 28, 1995, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, and the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Garden Grove does hereby declare, determine and order as follows:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts except absent voter ballots was 16,908.

That the whole number of absent voter ballots cast in the city was 5,182, making a total of 22,090 ballots cast in the city.

SECTION 2. That the measures voted upon at the election are as follows:

Measure Z - Shall an Ordinance establishing term limits of two consecutive four-year terms for the office of councilmember and four consecutive two-year terms for the office of mayor, be adopted?

Measure AA - Shall a new Ordinance which continues the transient occupancy tax increment of 2% (tax on renting of hotel and motel rooms), adopted in 1991-92 as established by Garden Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.12, be adopted?

Measure BB - Shall a new Ordinance which continues the business license tax based on gross receipts of the City of Garden Grove, adopted in 1991, as established by Title 5 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code entitled "Business Operation Taxes, Permits and Regulations," be adopted?

Measure CC - Shall an initiative ordinance to replace the existing water rate system of fees and charges of the city of Garden Grove, with a new system of standards and requirements to set fees and rates for water usage in the city of Garden Grove, including among other things, the requirement that all water users be charged the same rates regardless of the volume of water used, nature of the user's business, size of lot, or structures on the lot, be adopted?

Measure DD - Shall an Ordinance requiring the maintenance of the current water operation system and rate structure be adopted?

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the city for and against the measures were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on the measures relating to term limits and Transient Occupancy Tax did vote in favor of it, and that the measures were carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified. As a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on the measures relating to Business Operations Tax, the Water initiative and the City's water measure were not carried and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.


SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City of Garden Grove, a statement of the results of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the city; (2) The measures voted upon; (3) The number of votes given at each precinct for and against each measure; and (5) The total number of votes given for and against each measure.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
