STRUCTURE FIRE

RESPONDED ON A REPORTED TO STRUCTURE FIRE. UPON ARRIVAL FOUND SMOKE COMING FROM CHIMNEY AND FIRE BURNING UNDER THE EVES. FIRE WAS EXTINGUISHED BY PRE-CONNECTED HOSELINE AND ON BOARD WATER. GT1 OPENED UP THE ROOF SURROUNDING THE CHIMNEY. GE7 PULLED A HOSELINE TO THE INTERIOR AND EXTINGUISHED THE FIRE WITHIN THE FIREBOX COMPARTMENT.

THE FIRE WAS INVESTIGATED FOR ORIGIN AND CAUSE. THE RESIDENT STATED THAT THEY HAD BEEN BURNING WOOD PALLETS IN THE FIREPLACE THE NIGHT BEFORE. THE RESIDENT ALSO STATED THAT THE CHIMNEY FLUE WAS CLEANED SOMETIME IN OCTOBER. THE ORIGIN OF THE FIRE WAS WITHIN THE FIREBOX. IN MY OPINION, THE CAUSE OF THE FIRE WAS DO TO THE USER EXCEEDING THE RATED CAPACITY OF THE FIREPLACE BY BURNING WOOD PALLETS IN THE FIREPLACE. THE FLUE THEN OVERHEATED CAUSING THE SURROUNDING COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS TO IGNITE. THE FIRE WAS DETERMINDED TO BE ACCIDENTAL IN NATURE.
