INCIDENT REPORT

A ONE STORY COMMERCIAL TILT-UP WITH A FLAT ROOF TO FIND LIGHT SMOKE/SMALL FIRE FROM AN ELECTRICAL METER TO THE EAST SIDE OF THE EXTERIOR OF THE STRUCTURE. GE7 IN AN INVESTIGATIVE MODE. GE7 REQUESTED EDISON TO RESPOND TO THE SCENE. GE7 AND GT1 MADE ENTRY INTO THE UNIT ADJACENT TO THE ELECTRICAL METER TO FIND THE WALL OPPOSITE OF THE METER COLD AND WITH NO INVOLVMENT OR SMOKE IN THE INTERIOR OF THAT UNIT. UNIT OCCUPANT WAS ON SCENE AND PROVIDED ENTRY; NO FORCIBLE ENTRY WAS NEEDED. SMOKE/FIRE TO THE EXTERIOR ELECTRICAL METER EVENTUALLY WENT OUT WITH NO EXTINGUISHMENT FROM FIRE PERSONNEL NEEDED. BALANCE OF THE ASSIGNMENT WAS RELEASED AND GB1 AND GE7 REMAINED ON SCENE. GB1 DISSOLVED COMMAND AND GE7 REMAINED ON SCENE FOR THE ARRIVAL OF EDISON. EDISON ARRIVED ON SCENE AND METRO NET WAS NOTIFIED. SCENE RELEASED TO EDISON. GE7 COMPLETED.
