bludgeoning weapon or device capable of inflicting grievous bodily harm; and any firearm other than one carried pursuant to a valid permit, issued by a duly authorized governmental authority, or an ordinary rifle or shotgun lawfully carried for purposes of hunting or other lawful sport.

SECTION 4305. LOITERING. PROHIBITED.

No person shall, while carrying concealed upon his person any dangerous or deadly weapon, loaf or loiter upon any public street, sidewalk or alley or wander about from place to place with no lawful business thereby to perform, or hide, lurk or loiter upon or about the premises of another.

SECTION 4306. DISORDERLY CONDUCT.

No person who has concealed upon his person or who has in his immediate physical possession any dangerous or deadly weapon shall engage in any fight or to participate in any other rough or disorderly conduct upon any public place or way or upon the premises of another.

SECTION 4307. PUBLIC RESORTS.

No person shall, who has concealed upon his person any dangerous or deadly weapon, loiter about any place where intoxicating liquors are sold or any other place of public resort.

SECTION 4308. AUTOMOBILES.

No person shall have in his possession, in any automobile, any dangerous or deadly weapon, but this restriction shall not be deemed to prohibit the carrying of ordinary tools or equipment carried in good faith for uses of honest work, trade or business, or for the purpose of legitimate sport or recreation.

SECTION 4309. SALES TO MINORS.

Every person who sells to any minor any dirk or dagger or any knife with a blade three inches or more in length, or any snap blade or spring blade knife, regardless of the length of the blade, unless such minor is accompanied by an adult person and unless the person selling such dagger or knife keeps a full and complete record of the name and address of the purchaser is guilty of a misdemeanor.
