Thousands line Bolsa Avenue for annual Tet Parade

WESTMINSTER – Drumbats echoed and polychromatic balloons flitted skyward, as members of the Vietnamese-American community on Saturday paraded down Bolsa Avenue in celebration of the Lunar New Year.

Thousands thronged along the normally traffic-heavy street in the heart of Little Saigon Saturday morning for the annual Tet Parade, honoring the Year of the Goat, a more than three-hour spectacle of floats, military vehicles and Vietnamese dances.

The parade, had a greater significance this year, many said, because 2015 marks the 40th year the Vietnamese-American community has been in Orange County – a milestone that encourages reflection on how far the community has come.

“This parade preserves our culture and teaches the next generation about what the previous generation did in establishing this community,” said Tam Tran, who was part of the Miss Vietnam contingent that marched in the parade. “We get to come together and support each other, and remember our ancestors.”...

I am writing a story ahead of the Waterpark Hotel Resort's grand opening this week about the resort's prospects for success (and subsequently, payoff to Garden Grove taxpayers).

I'm reaching out because I am looking for your input into what you see as challenges to the hotel becoming a success and whether you see value in using public dollars toward hotel projects.

Are you concerned about the project's proximity to the coast/beach and its ability to compete with the Anaheim Resort? Given the cost to stay at the hotel, what kind of clientele do you think will choose to stay at the resort? Do you see it a competitor or complement to Disneyland?

The general criticism of hotel subsidies -- the city spent \$20.8 million to acquire the properties and paid an additional \$47 million to the developer -- is that they are funds that could go elsewhere: parks, public improvements, etc.

Do you think the public will receive a return on its investment in this project? What would you say to those who criticize the city for not spending more on neighborhoods, parks and other public facilities?

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SB 969 – Vietnamese Rice Cakes

SUMMARY

SB 969 would allow for an exemption in the Health and Safety Code for traditional Vietnamese Rice Cakes to be sold year-round, provided that they are labeled with health precautions warning that the rice cake must be consumed within three days.

BACKGROUND

Traditional Vietnamese rice cakes are manufactured primarily around the holiday seasons such as Tet. There are generally two forms of rice cakes that can take up to eight hours to cook; one with meat-filling and one with a fruit-filling. Traditionally, families will keep these rice cakes for up to one week before safely consuming, although many will refrigerate them by the end of the day. Due to current requirements established by the Department of Public Health due to the presence of perishable ingredients, Vietnamese rice cakes must be sold refrigerated or frozen. However, it is against tradition to purchase rice cakes that are cold. This stigma prevents traditional Vietnamese rice cakes from being sold year-round in stores without facing citations from the Department of Public Health regulators. Additionally, these cakes are often sold for charitable events to raise money during the holidays.

EXISTING LAW

The California State Legislature passed two measures that allow for similar exemptions for traditional cultural recipes. In 2001, AB 187 (Liu) allowed for Korean rice cakes to be sold, provided they have been at room temperature for no more than 24 hours. In 2010, the Legislature passed SB 888 (Yee) which similarly allowed for Asian rice based noodles to be sold, provided they

are labeled as perishable and are to be consumed within 4 hours of manufacture. Vietnamese rice cakes contain different ingredients and cooking methods so they are excluded from both of these current statutory exemptions.

THE SOLUTION

SB 969 would allow for perishable Vietnamese Rice Cakes that are cooked and served according to traditional recipes to be sold at room temperature for no more than 72 hours with appropriate warning labels.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The heading of Article 14 (commencing with Section 111222) of Chapter 5 of Part 5 of Division 104 of the Health and Safety Code is amended to read:

Article 14. ~~Asian Rice Noodles and Korean Noodles, Korean Rice Cakes, and~~
Vietnamese Rice Cakes

SEC. 2. Section 111223 of the Health and Safety Code is amended to read:

111223. (a) (1) All manufacturers of Asian rice-based noodles shall place a label on the packaging of Asian rice-based noodles that indicates the date and time that the product first came out of hot holding at temperatures above 135 degrees Fahrenheit and includes a statement that the Asian rice-based noodles are perishable.

(2) The product packaging shall only be labeled once.

(3) Notwithstanding paragraphs (1) and (2), this section shall not apply to Asian rice-based noodles that have a pH of 4.6 or below, have a water activity of 0.85 or below, or have been determined by the department to be nonpotentially hazardous foods based on formulation and supporting laboratory documentation submitted to the department by the manufacturer.

(b) All manufacturers of Korean rice cakes shall place a label issued by the Korean Rice Cake Association Corporation on the Korean rice cake that indicates the date of manufacture. The Korean rice cakes label shall include a statement that the rice cake must be consumed within one day of manufacture.



(c) All manufacturers of Vietnamese rice cakes shall place a label on the Vietnamese rice cake that indicates the date of manufacture. The Vietnamese rice cakes label shall include a statement that the rice cake must be consumed within three days of manufacture.

SEC. 3. Section 114429.3 is added to the Health and Safety Code, to read:

114429.3. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 113996 and 114343 and if permitted by federal law, a food facility may sell Vietnamese rice cakes that have been at room temperature for no more than 72 hours.

(b) At the end of the operating day, Vietnamese rice cakes that have been at room temperature for no more than 72 hours shall be destroyed in a manner approved by the enforcement agency.

(c) All manufacturers of Vietnamese rice cakes shall place a label on the Vietnamese rice cake as prescribed by Section 111223.

SEC. 4. No reimbursement is required by this act pursuant to Section 6 of Article XIII B of the California Constitution for certain costs that may be incurred by a local agency or school district because, in that regard, this act creates a new crime or infraction, eliminates a crime or infraction, or changes the penalty for a crime or infraction, within the meaning of Section 17556 of the Government Code, or changes the definition of a crime within the meaning of Section 6 of Article XIII B of the California Constitution.

However, if the Commission on State Mandates determines that this act contains other costs mandated by the state, reimbursement to local agencies and school districts

At the Garden Grove City Council meeting on March 22, our staff provided an update to the City Council regarding the City's existing contract with the County of Orange for animal care services and the County's current efforts to move forward with a design-build contract to construct a new animal shelter at the former Tustin Marine Base. Accordingly, the City Council was advised that the County is requiring its partnering cities to commit to both a capital contribution and a 10-year service agreement by April 30, 2016. Following that discussion, the City Council directed the City Manager to forward the following concerns and questions to the Board of Supervisors.

As the City of Garden Grove is considering the future of animal care services, the City Council is concerned about rising program costs, the potential \$35 million cost of building a new animal shelter and the need for enhanced communication with the public. Since FY 2011-12, Garden Grove's costs have increased 79% from \$729,000 to a projected \$1,307,631 for FY 2015-16. Additionally, the City is being asked to pay 13.8% of the new animal shelter cost, adding an annual shelter payment of \$430,828 to current service costs. For FY 2016-17, Garden Grove's estimated program cost, including the new shelter payment is \$1,738,459. This is a 138% cost increase over a six-year period. Moreover, if any cities opt out of the program, we understand that costs will be reallocated based on a new percentage, potentially increasing costs further.

Although the County has provided a justification for the increase in service costs, the City's revenues have not increased accordingly and the City is struggling with a structural deficit. Therefore, the City of Garden Grove would like to understand the strategies to control the costs of animal care and procedures that would assist the City with managing future costs. For example, can the County provide adequate animal care with a less expensive shelter and can the City be assured it will be allowed to participate in the new shelter design? Also, the City of Garden Grove would benefit from data and supporting cost calculations for the uncollectable fee revenue planned to be written-off by the County and billed to the City of Garden Grove. In order for the City to manage its limited resources, the County would need to provide accurate


calculations for the uncollectable fee revenue along with supporting justification indicating Garden Grove is responsible for the debt.

The City Council also expressed concern that Orange County Animal Care could provide better communication with the residents of Garden Grove. With a community as diverse as Garden Grove, it is essential that communication and public outreach by Orange County Animal Care be conducted in English, Vietnamese, and Spanish. A more effective communication program could assist Orange County Animal Care in increasing revenues through licensing compliance and decreasing the need for field and shelter services.

Although the City of Garden Grove has generally been pleased with the services provided by the County, the steep increase in costs over a short period of time is of great concern. As the City continues to deliberate this issue, any information that offers long-term cost containment assurances will be helpful to the City Council and the staff.

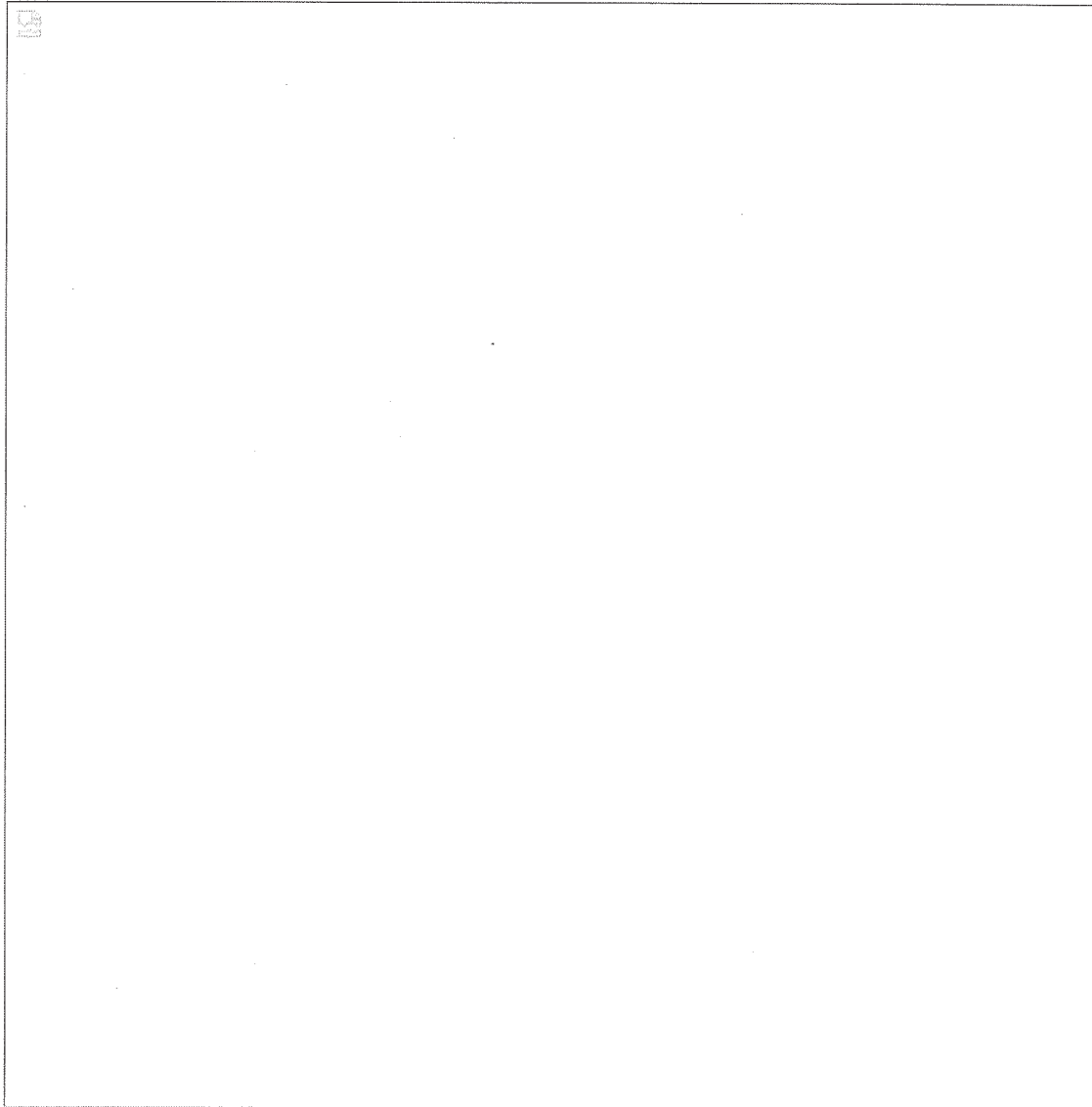

You are hereby required to provide healthy, live vegetation such as grass, ground cover, shrubs, trees or flowers in all areas of your front yard, and removing the excessive rock material in the front yard to retain no less than the fifty percent required for landscaping.
