The mosquito-borne virus Zika didn't come out of nowhere, but it kind of feels that way, given how rapidly it's spread both through the Americas and through public consciousness over the past month or so.

And now, after an emergency committee meeting that met by teleconference on Monday, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of the Zika virus a "public-health emergency of international concern." This is a rare designation, previously given to outbreaks like H1N1 in 2009 and Ebola in 2014, as my colleague Krishnadev Calamur reported.

The short version of Zika's history goes like this: It was identified in 1947 in the Zika forest in Uganda. For decades, it laid low in Africa and Southeast Asia, with just 14 documented cases until 2007, when the first major Zika outbreak hit Yap island in Micronesia. Other Pacific Islands began to see more cases, and in 2013, there was another outbreak in French Polynesia. The current outbreak began in Brazil in May 2015 and has since spread to 22 other countries in North and South America, plus Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. No one knows how Zika got to Brazil in the first place, but Reuters reports that the Brazilian government thinks a traveler to the World Cup may have brought it into the country in 2014.

On Tuesday, the CDC confirmed a case of sexually transmitted Zika in Dallas, Texas, in which a person spread the virus to a sexual partner after contracting it abroad. Prior to this, it was suspected that Zika could be sexually transmitted—traces of the virus were found in a patient's sperm during the French Polynesia outbreak—but no one knew for sure.

While the outbreak is now growing quickly—the WHO director general, Margaret Chan, declared Zika to be "spreading explosively" through the Americas—the emergency is not so much Zika itself, but the neurological conditions associated with it. Since last May, Brazil has seen an uptick in cases of microcephaly (a birth defect of small head size which can signal brain damage) and Guillain-Barré syndrome (in which the immune system attacks the nervous system). The WHO "strongly suspect[s]" a causal connection between Zika and microcephaly, though the link hasn't yet been proven; the connection with Guillain-Barré is likewise suspicious but not confirmed.

On its own, Zika isn't much to worry about—it's rarely fatal, and is typically milder than its more painful cousin dengue, though the two share symptoms like fever, rashes, and joint pain. Most people who are infected with Zika (four out of five of them) will never experience any symptoms at all. "For most of the non-pregnant population, there is no reason to think Zika presents a particular risk," the CDC director, Tom Frieden, wrote for CNN.

While this is great news for the casual traveler who just wants to visit Rio and avoid a rash, it makes it difficult to estimate how many people have actually been infected in this outbreak. If you've been infected with Zika, chances are you won't know it. It's a lurker. And now that we've seen it can be transmitted sexually,

that's doubly worrying.

Plus, it really complicates the picture for pregnant women. If Zika does cause microcephaly, a lack of Zika symptoms makes it hard to know who's at risk for having a baby with the birth defect.

But the number of cases of microcephaly in Brazil may be a little overblown—the Brazilian health ministry has reported around 4,000 suspected cases since October 2015, but these are just suspected, not confirmed. Some of those babies may just have small heads, and no developmental problems. The Global Post reports that the number of confirmed cases is much lower:

So far, of the original thousands of suspected cases, Brazil has confirmed 270 instances of children born with microcephaly since October 2015. And, significantly, 462 cases have been discarded, according to the ministry's numbers. So cases are being discarded at almost twice the rate that they're being confirmed.

"When you're studying something in epidemiology, there's always going to be a little bit of over-reporting compared to the confirmed number of cases of a condition," says Chad Achenbach, an infectious-disease specialist at Northwestern Memorial Hospital and Northwestern University. But even if some of those suspected cases don't pan out, the increase is still notable—from 2010 to 2014, microcephaly cases in Brazil were hovering around 150 per year.

"What you need to ask yourself when you see something like this is, 'Is there something else that could've explained this increase besides Zika?'" Achenbach explains. "You have to be careful with making those types of associations, but this is such a big increase and there doesn't seem to be any other particular reason."

"This is kind of an unprecedented outcome of this type of infection," he says. "We've never seen this type of birth defect with similar types of viruses." Not even with West Nile, which can cause neurological problems—like meningitis and encephalitis—in adults.

Zika is spread by two species of mosquitoes: *Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus*. These same mosquitoes can also transmit West Nile, dengue, and chikungunya—all diseases that have made inroads in the Americas in recent years.

"It is not surprising that [Zika] has followed a similar path of rapid expansion upon arriving in the Americas," Jane Messina, a senior postdoctoral epidemiologist at the University of Oxford, told me in an email. "*Ae. aegypti* are abundant in densely populated urban areas of this region, and so the populations in these areas, having no background immunity to Zika, are highly susceptible to infection."

Anthony Fauci, the director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, calls this "the perfect storm of an outbreak of a new mosquito-borne infection."

Zika's place on this family tree is complicated—it looks very similar to dengue and chikungunya, and because there is no commercially available diagnostic test for Zika, it can be hard to tell which one someone has.

(Right now, testing for Zika can only be done at the CDC Arbovirus Diagnostic Laboratory and some state health departments.)

But it's important—not just because of Zika's connections to microcephaly and Guillain-Barré, but also because dengue "is a bit more severe disease, requiring a bit more supportive care and monitoring," Achenbach says. In some people (particularly those who've had dengue before), it can develop into the serious dengue hemorrhagic fever. What's more, dengue, chikungunya, and West Nile are not sexually transmissible, so clarifying that someone has Zika is also clarifying whether they need to use condoms and protect their sexual partners.

There are no currently available vaccines or treatments for Zika. (Fauci says the NIAID hopes to have a vaccine in a Phase One clinical trial by the end of the summer.) The official CDC recommendation is just to protect yourself from mosquito bites if you travel to affected countries, and to avoid contact with the semen of someone who's been to those countries.

Pregnant women or women who are trying to get pregnant are advised to delay travel, or at least talk to their doctors before going. (This is a comparatively chill recommendation—as my colleague Uri Friedman reported, some countries with local transmission of Zika have advised women to put off having kids altogether.) If pregnant women returning to the U.S. from affected countries have Zika symptoms, the CDC recommends they be tested, with possible amniocentesis to check on the fetus if the results are positive. If they don't have symptoms, the agency still recommends at least an ultrasound. (There's a whole flowchart here.)

Up until now, the term "local transmission" has been used to mean that Zika is being spread via mosquitoes within a country. Achenbach says that sexual transmission also counts as local transmission, but it's unclear whether the new Dallas case will prompt the CDC to add the United States to its list of countries included in the outbreak. (I have asked the agency this question, but have yet to receive a response.) Regarding adding the U.S. to the list, Fauci says, "I think with a single case of sexual transmission I wouldn't go that far."

But it definitely shakes things up. "I think we have to reevaluate the whole concept of what local transmission is and what the role of returning travelers are," Fauci continues. "Because before, returning travelers would be considered as imported cases. But if the imported case has the potential of spreading [Zika], then we have to figure out ways that we can prevent that spread. So all of a sudden it adds a whole new dimension to what we mean by an imported case."

But the U.S. probably will, at some point, see transmission by mosquitoes as well. According to a model recently published in *The Lancet*, 22.7 million Americans live in regions of the U.S. where Zika could spread year-round, and 200 million, or 60 percent of the population, live in places where it could spread during warmer months.

Other than the sexually transmitted case, all the Zika cases in the U.S. so far have been in travelers bringing it home as an unwanted souvenir. A student at the College of William and Mary in Virginia recently contracted the virus after vacationing in Central America, and a handful of others have similar stories, including a woman in Hawaii whose baby was born with microcephaly and tested positive for Zika. The mother had lived in Brazil for a while last year. It's likely there will be some transmission from mosquitoes in the U.S. and possibly some "very limited small outbreaks, most likely in Southern states."

Please note: No one in the U.S. has yet contracted the virus through a bite from an American mosquito. For that to happen, the right kind of mosquito would have to bite an infected person who brought the virus from another country, become infected itself, then bite and infect someone else. Or, Achenbach says, an infected mosquito could hitch a ride on an airplane from another country and buzz off into the American sunset.

Achenbach says he thinks it's likely that there will be some transmission from mosquitoes in the U.S., and possibly some "very limited small outbreaks, most likely in Southern states—Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, Texas." But the virus should stay fairly contained, partially because cities in these areas tend to be less population-dense than cities in Central and South America, partially because "our mosquito-control programs are a little bit better," Achenbach says, and partially because so many people have window screens and air conditioning. The A/C helps because mosquitoes don't like cool temperatures, and neither does Zika—"the ability of the virus to replicate within the mosquito [is] hindered by lower temperatures," Achenbach says.

Despite all the unanswered questions and lack of treatments and vaccines, according to Fauci, the key to slowing and stopping the outbreak is old-fashioned mosquito control—insecticides and removing standing water. “How long the outbreak goes on depends on how well you control the mosquitoes,” he says.

Zika’s sudden appearance and rapid rise in the Western hemisphere likely owes a lot to both urbanization and international travel—when people cluster and move around, so do viruses. (The same can be said for Zika’s cousins in the region.) And a warming planet means there are more areas where these mosquitoes can thrive. However long this outbreak goes on, mosquito-borne viruses are likely here to stay in North and South America.

“Given that controlling the *Ae. aegypti* population and spread of other mosquito-borne viruses has been such a struggle in this region,” Messina says, “I don’t see any reason why Zika should now disappear from the Americas.”

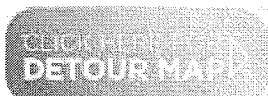
Full Closure East and Westbound State Route 91 (SR-91)

As part of the 91 Project that will bring improved transportation to Riverside County, SR-91 will be closed in both directions between State Route 71 (SR-71) and Interstate 15 (I-15) beginning **Friday, Feb. 19 at 9 p.m. until Monday, Feb. 22 at 4 a.m.**

When thinking about the weekend of Feb. 19-22, please plan ahead, avoid the area, or stay home.

The 55-hour closure will allow crews to perform three major construction activities:

- Demolish the west side of the Maple Street Bridge over the SR-91
- Install support beams for the new westbound Maple Street flyover ramp bridge
- Pave the new eastbound SR-91 alignment near I-15

A Letter from Artistic Director John Walcutt



HAPPY NEW YEAR!

January has flown by and already we are readying what looks to be a sensational new season under the stars at SOC: SHAKESPEARE | SUMMERFEST ORANGE COUNTY.

This will be my third season as Producing Artistic Director, and the 37th season of professional Shakespeare in Orange County. I tried to pick up where my old pal, Tom Bradac, left off after his remarkable 34 years carrying the torch. My main mission was to invigorate our company and audience, to infuse it with new energy from young people and from the diversity of the surrounding community, and to collaborate with other artists from Orange County in order to grow and fill the beautiful Garden Grove Amphitheatre. With your help, it's been fantastic. THANK YOU!

We've tripled our attendance over the past three years. We doubled our ticket sales in my first two years. We received our first corporate support from Macy's. 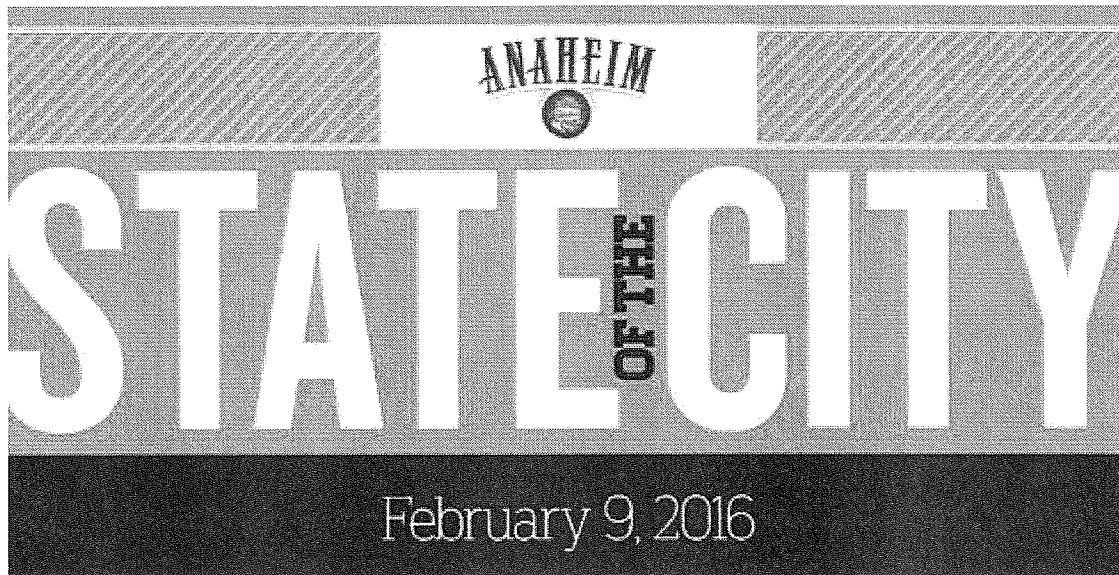

Dear Mr. Harper,

On behalf of the City Council, thank you for your email and information regarding your vehicle. We have looked into the circumstances regarding your claim and have determined that while unfortunate, the City's policies and procedures were followed and therefore we would not provide reimbursement for the fees charged by the tow company. Based on our records your vehicle was recovered by GGPD on 10/5/15, with occupants inside. The occupants were arrested and the vehicle was towed and stored per GGPD's normal operating procedures. (When a car is stolen outside of Garden Grove and the owner is not a Garden Grove resident, the vehicle is towed to a storage lot and the owner is then contacted.) Since you were on vacation when the car was recovered and your voicemail was not activated, GGPD records contacted your brother-in-law per the instructions you left with Huntington Beach PD. (HBPD was contacted because your car was stolen in Huntington Beach.) Your brother-in-law was notified by GGPD the same morning the car was recovered. (According to our records your brother-in-law did not pick the car up from storage until two days later.) The \$325 charge is the amount charged by the tow company, Country City Towing, for towing, dolly/hook-up charge due to flat tires, and two days storage. No City fees were charged. Since proper City procedures were followed, your claim for reimbursement was denied.

My issue is simple. The car when recovered was fully operational with the keys inside. There was NO need to tow and store it. Just make a call to the number on the report and we would arrive soon thereafter and recover the vehicle.

The city of Huntington Beach clearly would have done so and went so far as to have us provide a notarized letter for my brother in law to pick up the car while we were on vacation to avoid any storage fees. This was their idea. A simple TIMELY phone call would have saved us, the victims here, \$325. Additionally, our vehicle, while in possession of these animals suffered a few thousand dollars worth of damage and your DA refuses to make an attempt to prosecute them. They say the car was given to them by a friend using the possession of the key as evidence. To friends destroy other friends cars? This would not be a hard win but it just might take a little effort. A lack of effort seems to be the theme here.

Your memo seems to agree with the idea of a timely call making all of the difference. The car was in a parking lot. What would just a couple more hours, at most, have mattered. We should have been at least given a chance to recover the car.

NOTE: I had a car stolen from my work in Fullerton some 30 years ago. When it was recovered in Walnut I was notified and picked up my car. Easy peasy.

I am disappointed this simple courtesy was not offered to us. Geez, my wife's care was broken into last week and the Fullerton police found her purse and drove it to our home to drop off. That is my expectation, professional thoughtful courtesy.

I again request the reimbursement of the entire \$325 as a small compensation for all we have been through in hopes it will set an example of a higher level of service to the community in the future.

MAYOR'S TALKING POINTS GREAT WOLF LODGE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

REPORTER: "When you crunch the numbers it comes out to about \$100 million in taxpayer money to get Great Wolf off the ground."

- **These numbers are overinflated. The total investment into the project is:**

\$42 million bond, payable 30 days after the hotel opens

\$5 million for construction of parking structure

\$22 million maximum for land

APPROXIMATE TOTAL IS \$69 MILLION

- **The project is expected to generate \$8.5 million a year in general fund money for the City. That means in about 8 ½ years, the project will pay for the \$69 million investment.**
- **City did not pay for this project. The \$42 million bond money and \$5 million for the parking structure comes from the redevelopment agency trust fund. Another \$5.9 million comes from an EDA grant. The general fund is not impacted.**
- **Had the City not advocated for this project at the time of redevelopment dissolution, the state would have taken the agency trust money to use for other state purposes.**
- **This project was only 1 of 2 or 3 projects in Orange County that the state approved as meeting all of their criteria to receive redevelopment funding.**

IF THIS PROJECT DID NOT EXIST:

- **City would have lost the bond money to the state, and would not be reaping the \$8.5 million every year, that alone will represent about a quarter of the City's entire tax revenues.**
- **750 jobs that the hotel creates would be lost (nearly 10,000 people applied for these jobs).**

IF THIS PROJECT DID NOT EXIST (continued):

- **City would lose a critical funding source for increased Police and Fire personnel and equipment, as well as maintaining streets, parks, infrastructure, etc. and other services for the community.**
- **The businesses the hotel replaced were the Fire Station Motel and the Humdinger Bar. Two of the most ill-reputed businesses that existed in the City that attracted high criminal activity. *(Also the Town & Country RV park which had some controversy when tenants were relocated).***
- **Garden Grove would not be in the position it is in to continue attracting tourism and tourist dollars that represent a main source of the City's general fund dollars.**

OTHER FACTS ABOUT THE PROJECT:

- **Great Wolf Lodge has a history of successful projects. They promote the importance of spending time with family and are very environmentally conscious. They chose Garden Grove as the place to build their largest hotel. That is very prestigious for our city.**
- **The hotel is already booked at almost 90% capacity, and it doesn't officially open until February 19.**
- **This project is a win-win for the community and the City for many future years.**

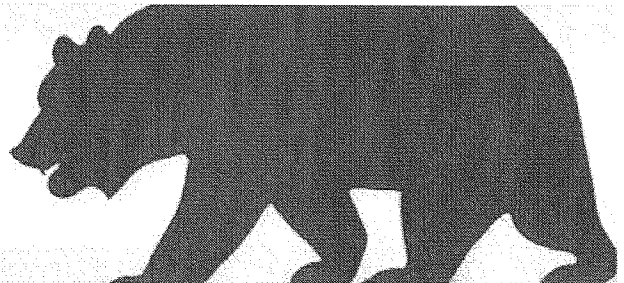

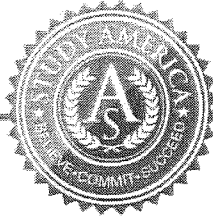

Hi Bao,

Last night's Olson meeting ended after 8:00 p.m. I was there talking to a few of the residents until about 8:30, who's concerns were basically the same as what you heard when you were there. The following is a synopsis of the basic concerns that were raised by the residents:

The general consensus of the residents is that they do not want to have residential units built on that site, nor did they want mixed use. The residents were concerned with the number of units that could be built there (the Olson representative said that on a 2 acre site they usually build between 55 and 60 units); the residents want the movie theaters to stay and would like to see more commercial there; the issue of increased traffic and the safety of children was raised; the residents felt that the commercial sites in the area were the center of their neighborhood; concerns that the residential development would reduce property values; and some of the residents felt that Olson was hiding information regarding their potential development proposal and they couldn't understand that Olson did not have a plan. There was also a consensus that the residents should, as a group, protest the development of homes and go to both the Planning Commission and City Council to voice their concerns.

Finally, a few people couldn't understand why Olson is including the theater site and not McDonald's or the bowling alley and why Olson would go into escrow without a plan. Olson didn't really respond to why they didn't include the other sites, although, I do know that Patti Widdicombe, who owns the McDonald's, recently got approval to rebuild the restaurant to be consistent with the new McDonald's prototype. As far as going into escrow without a plan, this is their due diligence period and they are getting input from the community to see if there is support for a potential project.

As a side note, I ended up explaining to the residents what the General Plan Land Use designation for the property would allow, which is mixed use with a residential density of 21 units per acre and a commercial component. I also let them know that the current zoning only allows for commercial development and it would require a zone change to have a mixed use project on that site. Additionally, I also mentioned that the General Plan Land Use designation was approved in 2008, however, in 2012 when the Code Amendment to create the mixed use zoning designations for the City, the proposal to create the mixed use

zoning for the Valley View and Chapman area, was removed from the Amendment and the zoning was left intact after the residents came out against it.

Dear Mayor Nguyen and City Council Members,

As you can imagine, West Garden Grove is very protective of the businesses and activities that occur in our area. When the Olson Company came out with a proposal to build residential properties on Valley View Street next to the Bowling Alley and McDonalds, there was quite a negative reaction to their proposal to build approximately 50-60 units at that location. On our West Garden Grove Neighborhood Watch page, in which I am an Administrator of the over 3,500 member group, there is quite a bit of chatter that is rejecting such a proposal for the west side of our great city.

The citizens of West Garden Grove feel that there is enough residential housing in the area, What we need is to add a grocery store, a few restaurants and to get more businesses to set up shop and not abandon the local industrial parks in our area. That is what the focus on any proposal should be, not one that will increase traffic and congestion in our tightly packed area. People here really need another grocery store - the fact that Vons owned the property at Lampson and Valley View and would only allow a 99 Cents Only store to replace their existing location is a slap in the face for those of us who live in the area. Most of us feel hostage by the Vons at Chapman and Valley View now that the Fresh and Easy has closed down. And the restaurant next to the 4-Star Cinema that is just sitting there closed up due to the greediness of the property owner does nothing to help us look for more restaurant options in the area.

I understand that you like to focus on the eastern part of the city with hotels, water parks and tourist attractions that can help generate revenues for the city. And just to let you all know, our Police Department is grossly understaffed and we need the expand the budget for more police officers to keep crime under control. As a member of the Police Chief's Advisory Board, I am not happy with the increase in crime from 2014 to 2015 and the fact that our great city can't put the badly needed resources into protecting our citizens and dealing with the criminal element that the state is releasing from prison only to see them coming to Garden Grove in search of opportunities to engage in criminal acts, from burglary to assault and even gang violence.

The citizens of West Garden Grove pay a good share of the city's property taxes and we want to be heard by the city council. We need some attention in order to work through the issues facing our section of the city, such as adding another grocery store, more sit down restaurants and making our industrial parks attractive to small businesses and reversing the abandonment rate so that we generate the maximum revenues and taxes for those businesses instead of letting them sit idle while the owners of those properties let the properties sit abandoned in deteriorating conditions waiting for the right proposal to come along to make a windfall at the expense of those who live around those properties.

These are the concerns of the citizens of West Garden Grove. I think it would be helpful to get the city

council and mayor out to the west side to participate in a town hall meeting so that together we can make this part of our city attractive and create a win-win situation for the city as well as its residents. That meeting can be organized as a Neighborhood Watch Meeting or as a separate meeting to share ideas and suggestions between ourselves. If you require the assistance from the West Garden Grove Neighborhood Watch to coordinate such a meeting, please let me know. I will work with the other administrators to get a location big enough for our turnout and we can discuss what we can do to make this area a great place to live, to shop and to attract both small and large businesses to our neck of the woods.

Hi Bao,

Last night's Olson meeting ended after 8:00 p.m. I was there talking to a few of the residents until about 8:30, who's concerns were basically the same as what you heard when you were there. The following is a synopsis of the basic concerns that were raised by the residents:

The general consensus of the residents is that they do not want to have residential units built on that site, nor did they want mixed use. The residents were concerned with the number of units that could be built there (the Olson representative said that on a 2 acre site they usually build between 55 and 60 units); the residents want the movie theaters to stay and would like to see more commercial there; the issue of increased traffic and the safety of children was raised; the residents felt that the commercial sites in the area were the center of their neighborhood; concerns that the residential development would reduce property values; and some of the residents felt that Olson was hiding information regarding their potential development proposal and they couldn't understand that Olson did not have a plan. There was also a consensus that the residents should, as a group, protest the development of homes and go to both the Planning Commission and City Council to voice their concerns.

Finally, a few people couldn't understand why Olson is including the theater site and not McDonald's or the bowling alley and why Olson would go into escrow without a plan. Olson didn't really respond to why they didn't include the other sites, although, I do know that Patti Widdicombe, who owns the McDonald's, recently got approval to rebuild the restaurant to be consistent with the new McDonald's prototype. As far as going into escrow without a plan, this is their due diligence period and they are getting input from the community to see if there is support for a potential project.

As a side note, I ended up explaining to the residents what the General Plan Land Use designation for the property would allow, which is mixed use with a residential density

of 21 units per acre and a commercial component. I also let them know that the current zoning only allows for commercial development and it would require a zone change to have a mixed use project on that site. Additionally, I also mentioned that the General Plan Land Use designation was approved in 2008, however, in 2012 when the Code Amendment to create the mixed use zoning designations for the City, the proposal to create the mixed use zoning for the Valley View and Chapman area, was removed from the Amendment and the zoning was left intact after the residents came out against it.

They want to know everything about their food and the companies that supply them - especially as it relates to ingredients and the impact on their families. ALDI is leading the supermarket industry in rightly responding to the science that shows the implications of these ingredients, and meeting the needs of the increasingly savvy consumers who don't want artificial or potentially harmful ingredients in the products they buy," Lempert said.

Aldi is best known for its low prices, in a recent price survey, it was shown that Aldi's prices are 30% lower than Wal-Mart. Aldi is able to keep such low prices by ordering food through specific sellers, instead of buying a wide variety of brands. They also cut costs by limiting store displays and advertising.

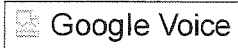
