- 3. Any form of education or enforcement of unsafe driving will have a positive effect on negative driver behavior. The mere presence of the posted signs throughout the city telling drivers that our program is in use first informs them before they get the intersection where the system is operating has a positive effect. There are other warning signs before the intersections well before the driver needs to decide how to react to the traffic signals allowing them another opportunity to contemplate the results of their actions should they think about driving through the red light. Finally, driving the posted speed limit and not being distracted will allow sufficient time to safely stop for the red light without the fear of being rear-ended or having to slam on your brakes. There have been many studies in the past by different groups interested in the programs effectiveness each with their own agenda. We are still collecting requested data but, the Police Department along with Public Works and Traffic Engineering are highly confident our program has indeed reduced significant injuries due to careless red light runners.
- 4. Last year our system captured 19027 red light runners. 11708 incidents were forwarded to the police department for review. Of those there are such things as uncontrollable factors such as obstructions, the driver being unlicensed or weather conditions to name a few which reduce the total number of incidents that can be processed or the number of Notices to Appear that find their way to the responsible driver. If there had been a Police Officer at the traffic light where these violations occurred we would have written 10,555 additional citations but, because of uncontrollable factors we could not so we only issued 7,577 notices in 2014.

See the attachment of the red light fines and penalties distribution. Note the fine is the same if an Officer stops you or the system captures your car violating the law.

5. Yes, the number of citations has changed over the years since the system has been in place. In 2013 the system captured 16,245 red light runners. I can also say that the largest majority of people violating the law are those people who live outside the city. We don't have a large police department or a traffic unit whose primary responsibility it is to enforce traffic laws so we've used technology to our advantage to maximize our lack of resources. In the past in court its been the Officer's word against the driver's word about where exactly the car was in relation to the limit line while the traffic light was red. Our system provides video of the violation which really is the best evidence of any violation and with that there's no doubt about exactly what happened.

- 6. Unlike some cities who have ended their programs ours have never been about revenue. We were the first city in Orange County to implement a system like this which we felt would save lives of drivers and pedestrians. If you compare having a uniformed officer in a marked patrol car stationed there all day and night throughout the year would be far more expensive. In fact, from a budget perspective, it would be an incredible waste for two reasons. First, the police would not be able to deal with other matters more serious. Second, they would be not be able to deal with other traffic violations that occur while they were stopping someone else so far fewer violations would be caught. This type of enhanced efficiency is exactly what the vast majority of voters generally insist on from the government no matter what it is doing. If one person was spared the death or severe injury that red light runners cause our efforts are certainly worth our efforts.
- 7. I don't believe there will be any one department by itself taking the responsibility to determine if we'll end our automated enforcement program. There are many professionals employed by the city each who have experience and expertise in their field who have contributed to the program and will continue to do so when called upon by city leadership.
- 9. Right now we are past the contractually agreed upon 60-day window where either party can terminate the contract. However, we are committed to allowing everyone who is interested in participating in the democratic process to do so and to assist the Mayor and Council so they can make an informed decision which will I think ultimately be up to them.

Hi David,

The GMSF firmware update will be released next week (likely mid-week) -

sorry that it was delayed, but from mid-week you should be able to do the firmware updates at the shop without Germany's help.

The flicker of the lights when ignition is turned-on or when the lights are turned-off has been addressed in new software for the flasher. I just received it yesterday and will be testing it this weekend.

In late July / early August, new GMSF software will be released that fixes all of the switch issues and makes all of the outputs shut-down after 30 minutes, so that may help if they have lots of consumers on the bike. I spoke with another agency with this complaint and they were not running the bikes much . mainly doing radar work and not really riding them, which is needed to recharge the batteries.

Regarding aux battery depletion, I have been running two voltmeters on my demo just to monitor the charging of the aux battery. This has been very informative as the aux battery will charge at idle if the main battery doesn't have too much load on it (heated grip, seat, motor-lights, etc.). It is also helpful to turn-off the lights to let the bike get more charge to the aux battery - perhaps if they are sitting idling - it makes a big difference.

I look forward to hearing from Bo.

Mark and I went out to the location and the runners should be south in the N/B lanes of Haster then divert them into the #1 lane of both N-S including

the painted center the divider, just before Allard Street. That will open up the #2 lanes for both directions which will allow for traffic. This should only be until Lampson. The runners at lampson are directed to the S/B lanes which gives the programmers room at the park to do something for the runners. That would allow traffic to flow to Lampson from the freeway (N/B) and for the vehicles that are south from Chapman. Then right before the apt complex and freeway off ramp, divert runners into the center again and then turn E/B in the W/B lanes of Garden Grove Blvd.

I hope I explained it well enough for you to see it on the map. The runners are diverted into the middle of Haster for a short time to allow for traffic to flow instead of land locking houses and an apt. complex.





AB 451: (Private Parking Facilities issuing citations) The bill allows local government to allow private parking enforcement in private parking facilities and provides for civil enforcement of private parking. Citations would not be reported to the DMV. There were some concerns expressed by some CPPA legislative committee members regarding the language in the bill and the potential for confusion by the public as to whether a citation was issued by a local agency or private party. The bill was reviewed carefully by Tim Yaryan, the CPPA's legal advocate, and he believes this issue is addressed by a requirement in the bill that there be a conspicuous statement on the citation to the effect that it is not issued by a local government. This bill is actively supported by the League of Cities. This bill was passed by the Assembly and Senate and is currently on the Governor's desk.

Some schools are under construction which will add to the frustration of drivers dropping off and picking up their kids. Although it is impossible to eliminate all complaints, we can try and reduce them by being proactive and having zero tolerance towards traffic offenders. The hours to enforce laws are generally in the morning from 0730 - 0830 and afternoon between 1330 -1430.

This has been an on-going problem for many years and is not going to go away. Last year, getting beat officers involved in combating the complaints along with motors reduced the number of complaints, but we were still reactive. 

Due to the successful reduction in Vehicle Vs. Pedestrian fatal traffic accidents (-34%), NTU will continue to do pedestrian and bicycle safety presentations during the 2015-year. Officer Morton conducted two pedestrian safety presentations. Officer Wimmer conducted two on-camera interviews regarding bicycle safety and pedestrian safety.

- This will include contacting the media and running another campaign raising awareness for pedestrian and bicycle safety. Officer Wimmer
- Hand out bright yellow/orange reflective vests and bike lights to citizens of Garden Grove.
- Continue to contact local businesses as well as senior citizen complexes and conduct presentations raising awareness. Officer Morton

Conduct two crosswalk safety enforcement saturations. We will use a decoy to walk across a major street in a crosswalk. The motor officers will be in the area and monitor the traffic and cite those who do not yield to the pedestrian while crossing the street. During the saturation, a designated location will be predetermined. Conducted one crosswalk safety saturation netted 70 citations

Conduct two bicycle safety enforcement days. Patrol will be encouraged to participate in this enforcement as well. Officers will specifically target bicyclists and issue citations for various infractions as they relate to bicycles. Each motor officer was devoted 22 hours to enforcement of bicycle/Pedestrian enforcement for a total of 154 man-hours.

Continue to educate and train patrol and specialty units on how to properly operate the Brazos Ecite machines. OBJECTIVE:

To obtain city council approval of upgrades made to the Driving Under the Influence (DUI) trailer assigned to the GGPD Traffic Unit, in order to organize and protect equipment from damage. The police department received a \$2100.00 donation from the Strawberry Festival committee for this upgrade.

BACKGROUND:

The DUI Trailer was purchased by GGPD through Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) funds from the 2011-2012 DUI Grant. The trailer was purchased through RB Components who were then a business in Garden Grove, however moved to Santa Fe Springs. Upgrades were needed to secure equipment used at DUI Checkpoints stored inside the trailer to prevent damage to equipment caused from transportation.

The DUI Trailer is a custom trailer specifically designed for police use at DUI Checkpoints. The trailer is an RB Components design, therefore, the only company contacted for custom upgrades was RB Components.

ANALYSIS:

In 2013, the Traffic Unit obtained a quote for upgrades needed from RB Components which was \$1,900.00. The upgrades were not approved due to the department was not in a financial position to allocate the funds. In 2015, the Strawberry Festival Committee donated \$2,100.00 for upgrades needed to the trailer. On 09/02/2015 the necessary upgrades were made at a cost of \$2,037.57 by RB Components.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council:

 Authorize the Police Chief, Finance Director and Finance Manager to execute the allocated Strawberry Festival Donation to RB Components.
