## TRAFFIC ENGINEERING STAFF REPORT

Traffic Concerns – Orangewood Avenue  
and Monarch Street

September 2, 2014

### OBJECTIVE

To consider a request for the installation of a four-way stop at the intersection of Orangewood Avenue and Monarch Street.

### BACKGROUND

The City has received a request and petition from Ms. Ilene M. Young of Saint-Gobain Plastics, 7301 Orangewood Avenue, to install a four-way stop at the intersection of Orangewood Avenue and Monarch Street. The request stems from the number of accidents that have occurred at the intersection.


### DISCUSSION

Orangewood Avenue is a secondary arterial roadway with a posted speed limit of 40 miles per hour. It has one lane in each direction with left turn pockets at Monarch Street. Traffic volumes on Orangewood Avenue are approximately 7,000 vehicles per day. Monarch Street is a two-lane street with a posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour. It has one lane in each direction with left turn pockets at Orangewood Avenue. Traffic volumes on Monarch Street are approximately 2,000 vehicles per day. Monarch Street is controlled by a stop sign on the north and south side of Orangewood Avenue.

A four-way stop sign warrant study for an arterial intersection was conducted. The study takes into account the entering volumes from all directions, accidents correctable with the installation of a four-way stop and any unusual conditions that exist such as visibility and design geometrics. The warrants for the number of accidents and traffic volumes entering the intersection were satisfied; therefore, the intersection warrants the installation of a four-way stop.

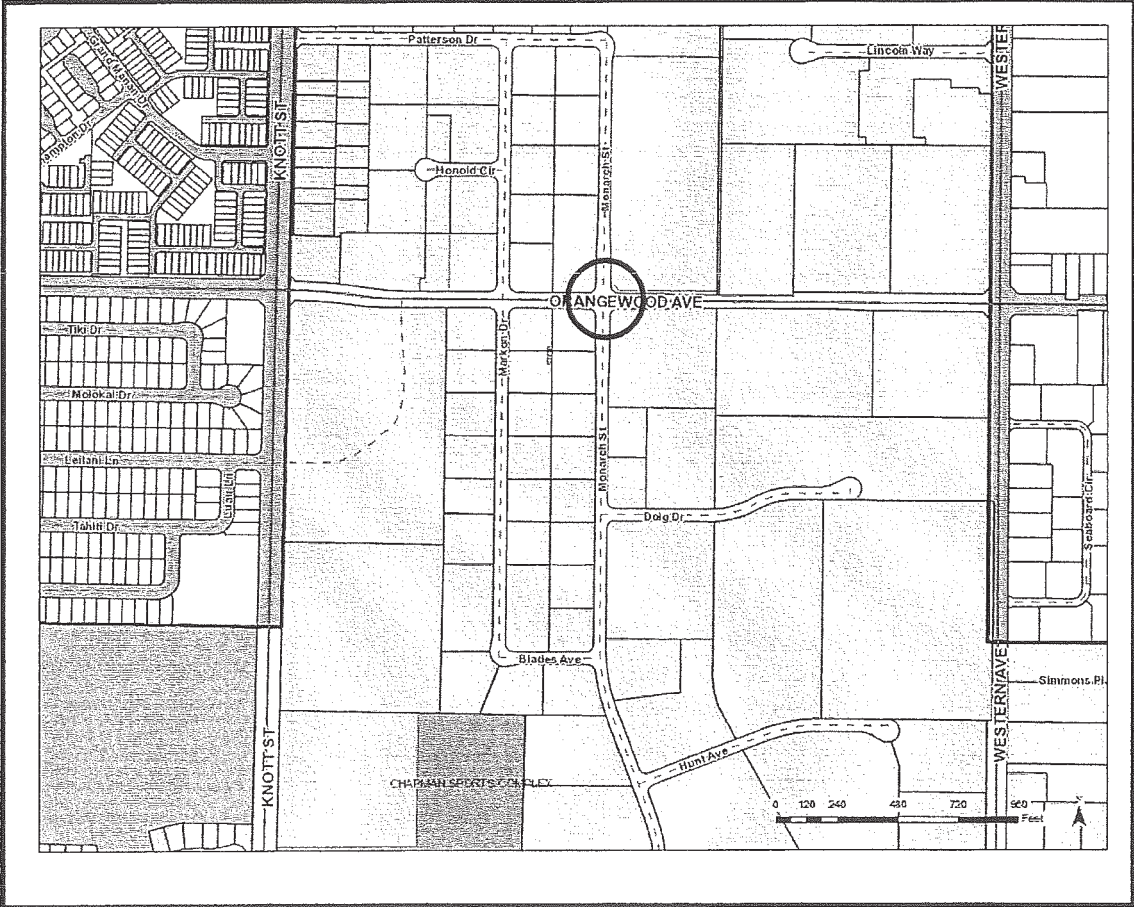
### RECOMMENDATION

**PURPOSE OF PETITION**

Our goal is to prevent accidents and injury by creating a 4-way stop with enhanced crosswalk markings at the intersection of Orangewood Avenue & Monarch Street in Garden Grove. In addition, we ask for signage advising motorists in all four directions, "SLOW FOR TRUCKS-DO NOT PASS".

**PETITION BACKGROUND**

Since 1999 I have personally witnessed numerous accidents at this intersection, as well as two hundred fifty feet (250) to the west of the intersection, directly in front of the Saint-Gobain, and Ferguson Company driveways. In addition to daily near-misses, the incidents range in severity from fender-benders to a fatality on October 3, 2013, with the most recent recorded occurrence on Jan 3, 2014. The current 2-way stop does not affect the speed of vehicles traveling east and west on Orangewood Ave, or allow pedestrians a safe crossing. It is our belief that the proposed changes to this intersection will reduce injuries and property loss by decreasing speed and deterring future incidents.

FOUR-WAY STOP SIGN WARRANT  
ARTERIAL INTERSECTION

GENERAL STATEMENT

This policy provides the criteria for the installation of four-way stop control at an arterial intersection in accordance with the policy approved by the City of Garden Grove City Council.

These warrants are a modified version of warrants found in the State of California Department of Transportation, Manual on Traffic Control. This warrant considers accidents, vehicle volume and pedestrian volume.

In addition, wherever unusual conditions exist such as visibility, design road geometrics, a four-way stop may also be warranted.

GUIDELINES

Field data relating to accidents vehicle volumes, pedestrian volumes and speed must be collected. These data are then applied to the criteria that follows to determine if a four-way stop is warranted.

Unusual Circumstances

It is recognized that there are unusual intersection situations which do not readily lend themselves to solutions through use of routine traffic engineering techniques, but safety can be improved by installation of four-way stop control. However, the existence of unusual circumstances does not, in itself, justify the installation of four-way stop control. Rather it must be demonstrated that a lesser restrictive type traffic control device fails to satisfactorily improve the unusual condition.

Accidents

Satisfied if five or more reported accidents of a type susceptible of correction by a four-way stop installation in a 12-month period.

Traffic Volumes

1. Total vehicular volume entering the intersection from all approaches must average 300 per hour for any 8 hours of an average day, and
2. The vehicular volume entering the intersection from the minor street for the same 8 hours must average at least 100 vehicles per hour.

If any of the above three warrants are satisfied, the intersection warrants a four-way stop.

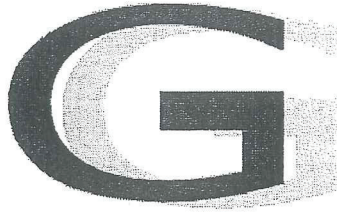
