A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE
ADJUSTING THE MONETARY PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE
AND GARDEN GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE PARKING REGULATIONS FOR WHICH THE CITY
ESTABLISHES THE FINE AMOUNTS

WHEREAS, during the 2010 legislative year, the California State Legislature enacted Senate Bill No. 857 ("SB 857"), which added Government Code Section 76000.3;

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 76000.3 requires the City to pay to the State an added penalty of three dollars (\$3.00) for each parking offense where a fine, penalty or forfeiture is imposed by the City;

WHEREAS, all funds collected as a result of the added penalty are transferred to the State Treasurer and deposited in the Trial Court Trust Fund for court construction purposes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to a legal notice, a Public Hearing was held by the City Council on February 26, 2013, and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, in adopting this Resolution the City Council of the City of Garden Grove is revising its monetary penalties for California Vehicle Code and Garden Grove Municipal Code parking violations, for which the City establishes the fine amounts, as required by state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Garden Grove does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The monetary penalty for all California Vehicle Code and Garden Grove Municipal Code parking violations, for which the City establishes the fine amount, shall be increased by the amount of \$3.00 over the presently existing fines to reflect the additional \$3.00 penalty imposed by SB 857 and Government Code Section 76000.3.

SECTION 2. City staff shall be directed to update the City's schedule of penalties for parking violations and late payment penalties for City Municipal Code and California Vehicle Code parking violations that are enforced by the City in a manner that is consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The parking violation penalty schedule hereby adopted is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15060(c)(3).
