FIRE

RESPONDED ON A VEHICLE FIRE LOCATED ON THE RIGHT SHOULDER OF THE EB 22FWY JUST EAST OF HARBOR. ON ARRIVAL, GE3 NOTICED A WELL INVOLVED VEHICLE FIRE. GE3 UTILIZED THE BUMPER LINE TO EXTINGUISH THE FIRE, AND VEHICLE OWNER AND OCCUPANTS WERE FOUND TO HAVE O INJURIES.

THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE STATED SHE SMELLED SMOKE COMING FROM THE VEHICLE AIR VENTS AND THOUGHT IT WAS FROM OUTSIDE. A LITTLE BIT LATER, ANOTHER VEHICLE TOLD HER SMOKE WAS COMING FROM UNDER THE HOOD OF THE VEHICLE. WHEN THE DRIVER PULLED TO THE SHOULDER OF THE FREEWAY, SHE NOTICED SMOKE AND FIRE COMING FROM UNDER THE VEHICLES HOOD.
