FIRE. STRUCTURE FIRE RESIDENTIAL. GE6 WAS ORIGINALLY DISPATCHED TO THE REPORTED LOCATION FOR A AFA RESIDENTIAL ACTIVATION. ENROUTE GE6 WAS NOTIFIED THAT THE CALL WAS BEING UPGRADED TO A STRUCTURE FIRE RESIDENTIAL RESPONSE. GE6 ARRIVED ON SCENE AND WENT INTO INVESTIGATION MODE WITH NOTHING SHOWING FROM THE EXTERIOR WITH RESIDENTS OUT FRONT. GE6 PERSONNEL MADE ENTRY INTO THE RESIDENCE AND NOTICED SMOKE EXITING DOWN THE HALLWAY FROM A REAR BEDROOM. FEMALE RESIDENT STATED THAT HAD KNOCKED DOWN A SMALL CONTENTS FIRE WITH A GARDEN HOSE. GE6 CONFIRMED THAT THE FIRE WAS KNOCKED DOWN AND THERE WAS NO EXTENSION TO THE STRUCTURE OF THE RESIDENCE. GB1 ESTABLISHED COMMAND AND ASSIGNED GE6 INTERIOR WITH GE3 TO ASSIST. GT1 / GM1 WERE ASSIGNED VENTILATION AND SALVAGE. AE3 HANDLED A POSSIBLE SMOKE INHALATION PATIENT TO THE FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE WHO LATER SIGNED OUT AMA. GT1 CAPTIAN ALONG WITH GE6 PERSONNEL QUESTIONED A FEMALE RESIDENT ABOUT WHAT HAD STARTED THE FIRE. RESIDENT STATED HER MOTHER WAS BURNING CANDLES IN THE BEDROOM AND THAT IT HAD ACCIDENTALLY STARTED SOME OF THE CONTENTS STORED IN THE ROOM. THE FIRE THEN SPREAD UP TO MORE CLOTHES AND BLANKETS STORED ON A SHELF. FIRE PERSONNEL OVERHAULED AND REMOVED FIRE AND SMOKE DAMAGED CONTENTS IN THE ROOM TO THE REAR OF THE RESIDENCE. RESIDENTS WERE ALLOWED TO ENTER AND GATHER VALUBLES AND OTHER NEEDED ITEMS. THE RESIDENCE WAS VENTILATED BY POSITIVE PRESSURE TO REMOVE SMOKE. COMMAND WAS DISSOLVED AND UNITS WERE RELEASED. GE6 PERSONNEL WENT OVER WITH RESIDENTS WHAT WAS DONE BY FIRE PERSONNEL AND REVIEWED FIRE SAFETY AND PREVENTION NEEDED TO NOT HAVE ANOTHER INCIDENT LIKE THIS ONE OCCUR AGAIN. PROPERTY RELEASE WAS FILLED OUT AND A SIGNED BY PROPERTY OWNER (WIFE): MINDALINA MALLARI. GE6 COMPLETE.
