Malamute mix, Male, Adult, Color: Black/Grey/White

July 19, 2017

Presented to Community Veterinary Hospital. Brought in by Garden Grove Animal Control. Pet not ambulatory, possibly hit by car, found this morning.

Weight: 78 pounds

Temperature 102.9, HR 112, RR Panting.

BARH, pink/moist MM, CRT <2 sec. No active bleeding noted

No HM, Increased bronchovesicular sounds. No arrhythmia, wheezes or crackles noted.

Strong synchronous femoral pulses. Pet unable to ambulate. CP deficits bilateral pelvic limbs. Withdrawal reflexes intact on both pelvic limbs. Broken nails noted on digits 3&4 of both hind limbs. Soft/Non-painful abdomen. Normal PLN's.

A: Absent CP bilateral pelvic limbs, non-postural, non-ambulatory

R/O spinal injury, vertebral fracture, pelvic fracture, HBC

P: Recommend Bloodwork/Urine - see attached results

Abdominal and pelvic radiographs - abdominal radiograph and spinal radiograph unremarkable.

0.3 mg buprenex IM

IV catheter, LRS, Bvit, 1 gram Cefazolin/ liter

Rate: 140ml/hour

Dexamethasone 2 mg SC

Monitor IV fluids

July 20, 2017

Ate well, normal urination

BAR pink/moist mm, CRT <2sec

Temp: 101.9, HR 100, RR panting

No Heart murmur, arrhythmias, wheezes or crackles. Increased bronchovesicular sounds.

Strong synchronous femoral pulses.

Pet can ambulate today but has severe ataxia and requires support/sling for walking.

Marked improvement compared to yesterday.

Absent CP bilateral pelvic limbs. Motor intact, Withdrawal reflex intact in all 4 limbs.



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Assessment: Bilateral CP deficits in pelvic limbs (marked improvement compared to yesterday in regards to ambulation)

Rule out spinal injury, trauma, IVDD

Plan: Continue with IV fluids – LRS, B vits, cefazolin, dextrose. Rate 140 mls/hour.  
2 mg dexamethasone IM

Monitor fluids

Talked to Mark. May need to pick up and transfer to humane society.

7/21/2017

Ate well. Normal urination, No Bowel movement overnight

Temp 101.6, Heart rate 132, Respiratory rate panting

No heart murmur, no arrhythmia, wheezes, or crackles. Strong synchronous pulses

Soft non-painful abdomen. Normal PLN's

Pet able to ambulate without sling support. Ataxic both hind limbs and absent CP's both hind limbs.

Assessment: Bilateral CP deficit in pelvic limb

Plan: Stop IV fluids today. Transition to oral dexamethasone.

RX: 0.5 dexamethasone BID for 5 days, 1 tab once a day for 7 days, 1 tab every other day for 7 days.

7/22/2017

Ate well. Urinated in treatment area, very concentrated. Had bowel movement.

Temp 102.3 Heart rate 130, respiratory rate 40. Mucous membranes pink.

Abdomen – soft. Ambulatory front legs, hind legs need sling support.

CP deficits pelvic limbs

Assessment: Hind limb CP deficits – rule out IVDD vs. other

Plan: Food / water

Dexamethasone 0.5 mg 1 tablet PO BID, see schedule to taper dexamethasone.

7/23/17

Alert / Good appetite

GROS – no change

Unable to stand without support

Will walk a few steps with support, non-ambulatory without support

Assessment: IVDD severe

Plan: 0.5 mg dexamethasone PO BID

Walk BID with sling



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7/24/17

Temp: 101.4

Alert, pink mucous membranes, friendly

EENT/PLN's - dental tartar

Heart / Lungs: 100 rate, regular. No murmur, clear and eupneic

Abdomen: Relaxed, no masses

Musculoskeletal: Bilateral CP deficits hind end. Cannot support hind end weight. Ataxia / falls over. No obvious fracture or pain.

Assessment: Rule out IVDD, Open, non-postural, non ambulatory

Plan: Talked to Garden Grove Animal Control about poor prognosis. Recommend humane euthanasia due poor prognosis. Discussed with Alfred.

Ok to euthanize. No owner has come forward. Poor quality of life/grave prognosis for recovery/use of hind limbs

Telezol 200mg intramuscularly, 9 mls Beuthanasia IV

Hold body. Garden Grove Animal Control will pick up on 7/25/17.
