INCIDENT REPORT

GE6 responded to the above address for structure fire. Upon arrival GE6 found heavy smoke coming from the parking structure of the apartment complex. GE6 went into the attack mode, initiated a primary search and started extinguishing the fire. GE3 came on scene and established command and two-out. GB1 arrived on scene shortly after and took command from GE3, assigned GLF-1 to vent group and AE3 to back up fire attack. Fire was quickly knocked down by fire personnel. Fire was confined to a single vehicle in the rear of the parking structure. Once scene was secure it was released back to the owner's representative. No injuries to civilians or fire personnel.

The fire was investigated by Captain/ Arson Investigator Kuhlman. The fire was confined to the engine compartment of the vehicle. The cause of the fire was unspecified mechanical failure in the engine compartment. Owner of the vehicle stated that he had a gasket valve adjustment recently done to the car at Honda World in the City of Westminster.
