Fire- Veg/tree fire

GE6 responded to the above address for a structure fire. Upon arrival GE6 had heavy smoke showing from the backyard of the residents. GE6 investigated and found multiple trees and vegetation on fire with high voltage electrical lines down. E6 went into the attack mode and started extinguishing the fire with 150ft pre-connect hose line. Fire did extend to one side of the detached garage but we were able to get an aggressive attack to keep it from spreading any further. Gel assumed command and assigned GE6 fire attack and GT1 vent group. Command was transferred over to GB1 once he arrived on scene. GB1 assigned GE3 to Div D. and expedited SCE for the wires down. Fire was knocked down/controlled with hose lines in place and kept to the area of origin. SCE arrived on scene shortly after and cut power to the entire block. No injuries to the homeowner or firefighters.

Cause of the fire appears to be electrical do to the high voltage lines that where found down at the scene. Homeowner did state he heard a loud explosion/pop prior to the fire. The property was released back to the homeowner and fire personnel went back into service.
