

1. NR Development, Inc. v. Facility Makers, Inc. Case #PSC1805678

Status: Closed. Dismissed with prejudice on 7/1/2019

On or about April 3, 2017, NR and Facility entered into a Subcontract Agreement under which Facility Makers, Inc. was, among other things, to provide structural steel fabrication and primer services for a project known as the Carport and Shade Structures Projects for the Sanitary District in Indio, California. Facility Makers, Inc. failed to follow the terms of the Agreement, thereby causing NR to hire a sandblasting company to repair Facility's work. NR provide Facility with multiple opportunities to correct the faulty work all of which were refused by Facility. NR sent Facility notices which informed Facility of the issues with its work. The Agreement incorporates the general contract between NR and the District which states, "The Owner shall report to the Contractor, through the Architect any such defects found, and the Contractor shall make all repairs with reasonable promptness." Therefore, Facility was obligated to remedy faulty work and NR is obligated to ensure all subcontractor work is not faulty. Due to Facility's refusal to correct its faulty work, NR was obligated to perform corrective work. NR is informed and believes and based thereon alleges that as a direct, foreseeable, and unavoidable result of Facility's breaches of the Agreement described herein, and despite NR reasonable and diligent efforts to mitigate damages, NR has been damaged in an amount to proven at trial. NR and Facility Makers entered into a settlement agreement on 7/1/2019, and the case was dismissed with prejudice at or around the same day.

2. <u>NR Development Inc. v. Prengler, Inc.</u>, as against Prengler, American Contractors Indemnity Company (ACIC), Case No. 19CV348398.

Status: Settlement reached on 107/2019. Will be dismissed without prejudice when settlement terms are fulfilled by Prengler.
