You are hereby required to replace any damaged wood trim, replace/repair the edge metal on the roof in front of the house and paint any areas of your home that are in a state of disrepair. (GGMC 9.32.200(B)(7))

Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. You must obtain permits for all un-permitted alterations on the property. (G.G.M.C. 18.04) (C.B.C. 105.1).

The scope of the work to be covered by the permit includes, but is not limited to:

- 1) Installation of new heater.
- 2) Installation of new water heater.
- 3) Ensure that there are no water leaks in the house, specifically under the kitchen sink.
- 4) Repair/replace any faulty light fixtures that are attached to the house, specifically outside the garage door.

To assure compliance with the Garden Grove Municipal Code, corrective measures should begin now and should be completed **within 7 day(s)** from the date of this notice.

Our main goal is to obtain voluntary compliance. However, if additional inspections are necessary after the initial compliance inspection confirms that corrections have not been completed, a re-inspection fee may be charged.

Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. You must obtain permits for all un-permitted alterations on the property. (G.G.M.C. 18.04) (C.B.C. 105.1).

The scope of the work to be covered by the permit includes, but is not limited to:

- 1) Installation of new heater.
- 2) Installation of new water heater.
- 3) Ensure that there are no water leaks in the house, specifically under the kitchen sink.
- 4) Repair/replace any faulty light fixtures that are attached to the house, specifically outside the garage door.

To assure compliance with the Garden Grove Municipal Code, you need to obtain the required permit(s) **within 14 day(s)** from the date of this notice. Failure to correct the above violation(s) may result in issuance of a misdemeanor citation, an Administrative Citation or referral to the City Attorney for criminal prosecution.

If additional inspections are necessary after the initial compliance inspection confirms that corrections have not been completed, a re-inspection fee of \$70.00 will be charged for the first re-inspection and \$100.00 for the second and subsequent inspections until compliance is gained.








Performed hydro scan to ensure safety of furnace and system failed hydro scan where water has leaked into clamshell style heat exchanger when sprayed on the outside of the heat exchanger. The heat exchanger has began to separate and create an unsafe operating condition.
