The following items were discussed:

- Introductions of Team Members
 - Garden Grove: Ken Vu will manage the project for the City and will be the main contact. Dai Vu will provide as needed support to the project.
 - AGA Engineers, Inc. (AGA): Greg Wong will be the project manager and in charge of the overall project. Ruben Perales will be in charge of the systemic analysis and reporting, Roland Hizon will be in charge of the data collection and cost-benefit-ratio and monitor the HSIP and ATP funding dates. Ignacio Sanchez (not present at the meeting) will be in charge of the recommendations and estimates. Chalap Sadam will oversee the project and provide QA/QC.
- Greg provided a brief overview of the project and objectives which reflect the State's goal of reducing fatal and severe injury collisions. He explained the emphasis areas and basic steps that AGA plans to take in the development of the LRSP. AGA will begin the collision analysis prior to meeting with the working group. This will provide the working group will information and data to work from.
- AGA will go over the different countermeasures and what the City preference is during the collision analysis. AGA will provide both minor and major countermeasures and determine which ones can be used for future funding applications and which ones may be implemented in the near term.
- Greg explained that AGA will first put a preliminary list of stakeholders for the working group for the City to review (see attached). City mentioned that the Police Department (traffic

motor officer) and the Traffic Commission (four new members) are two stakeholder groups to include in the working group. The City will provide a final list of stakeholders for the working group.

- The collision assessment was discussed. The City will update the data in Crossroads and provide the collision database to AGA. Ruben and Chalap requested data for the last five years, from mid-2020 be provided and the highest collision intersections will be evaluated.
- Roland explained the next HSIP and ATP call for projects, including next year cycle dates. City mentioned that they are open to add bicycle lanes.
- Dai asked if the LRSP final report needs to be adopted by City Council. AGA will check if it needs to be taken to Council.
 - Update: Per the OCTEC luncheon meeting of 2-25-21, it was brought up that the LRSP document is not a public document, however, "if" it is taken to council, then the public will be able to review it. We think the document does not need to be taken to Council and will check on the requirements for City approval.
- City mentioned to include the following intersections in the analysis.
 - Valley View St/Lampson Ave
 - Brookhurst St/Woodbury Ave
 - Chapman Ave/Lamplighter St
