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B. Work completed in Southern California

a. Tapia Landscaping has completed and fulfilled contracts with the County of Riverside. Multi-purpose trail maintenance – Maintains decomposed granite trails weekly free from weeds, applied pre-emergent and/or post -emergent to prevent or remove weeds, raked and fine graded trails 3 times per year, and added decomposed granite where needed to maintain a compact and uniform surface.

Tree care- Maintains tree/pedestrian conflicts up to 12', controls all pest and diseases including rodents, removal of damaged branches, remove branches blocking street signs, and re-stake and support trees where necessary.

Irrigation inspection and repairs – Maintains the complete irrigation system in operable conditions at all times, CLCA certified irrigation technician completes weekly inspections and makes necessary repairs where needed, adjusts water application to compensate for changes in weather.

Fertilization, Post-emergent and Pre-emergent – Slow released fertilizer is applied 4 times per year to plant material according to their individual needs to maintain good health vigor and color throughout the year. Apply post-emergent systemic herbicide and/or pre-emergent systemic herbicide as needed or requested by County Inspector. Prior to chemical application, signage is posted at the location of application.

The work included will consist of furnishing all labor, equipment and materials and performing all operations in connection with the landscape maintenance requirements for "RFP No. S-1304 as specified in Attachment A "Specifications for Landscape Maintenance Contract". It will be the responsibility of Tapia Landscaping to plan, inspect and provide maintenance for the locations as stated in RFP No. S-1304 and to respond to any unforeseen emergencies. Tapia Landscaping agrees that all services performed here under shall be provided in a manner commensurate with the highest professional standards and shall be qualified and experienced personnel; that any work performed by Contractor under the contract will be performed in the best manner; that any material furnished shall be subject to the approval of the Landscape Maintenance Inspector; and that both work and materials will meet fully the requirements of this RFP. Work shall be continued at all times with such force and equipment as will be sufficient to complete it within the specified time frames. The Contractor expressly proposes that it has taken into consideration and made allowances for all ordinary delays and hindrances to the work to be performed and will complete the work within the specified time frames.

All work shall be done and completed in a thorough, professional manner, notwithstanding any omission from this RFP, and it shall be the duty of the Contractor to call attention to apparent errors or omissions and request instructions before proceeding with the work. All materials furnished and all work done must be satisfactory to the Project Manager. 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a. Protection of Property:

Tapia Landscaping shall safeguard all public and private property from damage or loss. If any damages do occur during duties Tapia Landscaping will notify the City immediately.

b. Maintenance Deficiencies/Corrections Timeframes:

Tapia Landscaping shall redo at its own expense any part of this contract that is not up to industry standards and per the standards as described in this RFP.

c. Communications Regarding the Work:

Tapia Landscaping will communicate via email or cell phone and will include pictures of any problems and/or questions as required.

d. Emergency Work:

Tapia Landscaping will handle all emergencies in accordance with this RFP and respond immediately or within 24 hours.

e. Inspection:

Tapia Landscaping shall perform a weekly inspections of the complete Maintenance Areas.

f. Schedules:

Tapia Landscape will follow scheduling requirements per, Initial Schedules, Revised Schedules, Minimum Frequency Schedule, and Maintenance Schedules and Reports.

g. Subcontractors and Cooperation with Other Work Forces:

Tapia Landscaping will perform all work and will not be using subcontractors during the deration of the contract.

h .Office, Telephone, and Cell Phones:

Tapia Landscaping will maintain office hours, and provide telephone services to communicate with County Officials. After hours line will be provided for any unforeseen emergencies.

i. Materials Storage:

Tapia Landscaping will not use any City property or facilities as storage.



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j. Materials:

Tapia Landscaping shall maintain a stock of high usage items for repair an or replacement parts on all service vehicles (ie. tree stakes, ties, trash bags etc.).

k. Safety:

Tapia Landscaping will uphold all safety standards required by the industry and County including, Equipment Safety, General Safety, Protection of Persons and Property, Protection from Hazards, and Differing Site Conditions.

1. Cleaning and Environmental Controls:

Tapia Landscaping will maintain areas free of waste materials, debris, and rubbish, as well as all cleaning standards as described in this RFP.

m. Vehicle Limitations:

Tapia Landscaping shall at no time drive vehicles on turf, medians, and sidewalks for any reason.

n. Traffic Control, Public Convenience and Safety:

Tapia Landscaping shall conduct its operations so as to offer the least possible obstruction and inconvenience to the public, and shall have underway, no greater length or mount of work than can be prosecuted properly with due regard to the rights of the public.

o. Signage:

Tapia Landscaping shall display signs indicting companies name and license number on all vehicles. Tapia Landscaping will not post advertising signs or banners within the Maintenance areas. Tapia Landscaping shall remove all unauthorized signs and advertising within the Maintenance Areas.

p. Customer Service Standards:

Tapia Landscaping shall always represent the City in a professional, friendly, efficient and cost-effective manner.

q. Permits and Licenses:

Tapia Landscaping shall obtain all permits required by other agencies of the State and Counties. All permits and licenses shall be obtained by and at the expense of the Contractor.



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E. Work Plan / Approach

I. Landscape and Facility Maintenance

Tapia Landscaping will tailor a landscape maintenance program to suit the property needs, services will include the following:

- 1. Lawn Care
- 2. Shrub & landscape
- 3. Tree Care
- 4. Trash and debris removal
- 5. Rodent/pest control

II. <u>SERVICES PERFORMED</u>

1. Landscape Maintenance:

- a. Per City guidelines all vegetation shall be trimmed shaped and thinned to maintain adequate line of sight for public safety. In addition to this the following will services will be performed:
 - 1. Remove all animal feces, broken sharp glass and other objects; free from landscape areas.
 - 2. All dead vegetation will be removed where applicable.
 - 3. Shrubs and trees will be raked along with removal of debris.

2. Turf Maintenance and Edging:

- a. Turf areas will be maintained i.e., mowed and edged weekly, April 1st thru October 31st, biweekly November 1st thru March 31st; as conditions dictate.
- b. Various mowing patterns will be employed to insure the even distribution of clippings and to prevent ruts in the turf caused by mowers.
- c. Turf will be cut at desired and specified height in accordance with the City of Garden Grove requirements; ensuring health enhancement and vigor during the mowing process.
- d. Tapia Landscaping will edge areas adjacent to the turf, such as, walks and paved areas will be left in cleaned and neat condition.
- e. Tapia Landscaping will aerate turf annually or upon request from City Inspector.
- f. Chemical application will be applied by Tapia Landscaping; upon the request of City Inspector.



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3. Tree Maintenance:

- a. Tapia Landscaping will maintain trees, shrubs and other plants in healthy, growing condition, free from disease, insects, and pests.
- b. Tree Limbs will be cleared of sprouts from trunk. "Lifting" limbs 9' to 15' above ground; ensuring ample height for; in which all tree debris will be removed at the end of each business workday.
- c. Monthly, Tapia Landscaping will maintain staking and guying; adjusting as needed.

4. Fertilization/Weed Control:

- a. Twice a year Tapia Landscaping will provide fertilization services.
- b. A weeding program will be implemented on an ongoing basis; ensuring landscape projects are free of weeds and debris.
 - 1. Weed control will consist of removing weeds from all sites by mechanical/manual means.
 - 2. In the event chemical application is needed Tapia Landscaping will post "Safety" signage to ensure awareness of affected areas and community safety.

5. Trash and Debris Removal:

- a. Tapia Landscaping will remove all trash and debris from landscape and hardscape areas
- b. Trash and debris will be hauled away and appropriately disposed of.

6. Rodent/Pest Control:

a. Monthly inspections will be performed once a month at all sites to ensure landscape areas are free from rodent and pest. In the event treatment is needed, proper precautions will be taken to prevent contamination of the affected areas.


