License by Mail

Send copies of all required paperwork. A Garden Grove License Application is available at www.petdata.com, but is not required.

Determine the correct license fee for each of your pets. Make your check or money order payable to "City of Garden Grove" Please do not send cash. The license will be issued only after all required documents are received.



License Online

Any required documents, such as your pet's rabies vaccination certificate, may be scanned and uploaded or submitted later by fax, mail or email. The license will be issued only after all required documents are received. Visit www.petdata.com, and enter your zip code under "License Now" to get started. All major credit cards are accepted.



If you are licensing for the first time, you must purchase a license for any pet that is over the age of 4 months old. Licensing cats is voluntary, but encouraged. A late fee is added to the license fee if your license is not obtained or renewed within 15 days after the license becomes due. New licenses expire 1 year from the date of purchase. Renewal licenses expire 1 year from prior license expiration date. Rabies vaccination must be current at time of licensing. Late fee is \$35.

Altered dog \$27

Unaltered dog \$100

Senior Citizen (65+) altered dog \$13.50

Puppy License (under 6 months) \$27

Voluntary cat license \$6

Late Fee (15 days past license expiration) \$35

- A current rabies vaccination certificate is required if one is not already on file. Be sure to check your pet's certificate for correct address and pet information.
- Proof of spay/neuter, such as a signed statement from a veterinarian or an invoice for services is required if the pet has been altered since the last licensing period and you are applying for the lower spayed/neutered license fee.
- Proof of Senior Citizen status, such as a drivers license or other government-issued documentation with date of birth listed is required for Senior Citizen discount.
- Your paperwork will not be returned to you, so please retain a copy of your documents for your records. Visit www.petdata.com for more information.

HOW TO LICENSE ONLINE

Visit www.petdata.com and enter your zip code under "License Now". Click "Online" in the green "License Now" box. You will be taken to the "License Online" page. To license your pet online, click the text "Click here to begin". You will be taken to the City of Garden Grove online licensing page.

If you have received a license mailing, please log in using the reference number from that mailing.
