 - Seven days a week coverage.
- Statistics
 - Homeless contacts 3982
 - Referrals 978
 - 47 people sent directly into shelters via officers. This includes rehabilitation, Project Roomkey, etc.
- Partnerships
 - Outside agencies, Neighborhood Improvement and Code Enforcement-Community and Economic Development Department, Public Works Department, Crime Prevention, P.E.R.T.
 - Created online trespass form.
