



PROGRAM INFORMATION

INTRODUCTION

The City of Garden Grove (“City”) has established the JOBS 1st To-Go Program (“Program”) to stimulate economic growth through job retention activities aimed at assisting local food and drink establishments during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. The Program provides financial assistance for the purchase of goods necessary to accommodate delivery and take-out orders (i.e. containers, plates, cups, silverware, etc.), as well as the payment of 3rd Party delivery service fees.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible businesses must:

- ◆ Be located in Garden Grove
- ◆ Possess a valid GG Business License & applicable permits
- ◆ Be a food or drink establishment offering to-go options
- ◆ Retain at least one job for a low-income employee
- ◆ Show a minimum 25% decrease in revenue as a result of COVID-19

FUNDING OPTIONS

Eligible businesses may apply for one of the following types of assistance:

- ◆ A grant of up to \$1,000 to purchase the goods necessary to accommodate delivery and/or carry-out orders
- ◆ You may qualify for an additional \$500 if goods purchased are from a local Garden Grove business and/or distributor
