Background

In 1999, through a unique partnership between the City of Garden Grove, local service providers, and residents, the City of Garden Grove established the Magnolia Park Family Resource Center. Located in one of Garden Grove's underserved communities, the Magnolia Park Family Resource Center has enriched the lives of approximately 25,000 residents and 12,000 families since its inauguration. This year marks the 21st anniversary of the center. To commemorate the milestone, the City of Garden Grove commissioned and displayed a mosaic at the front entrance of the building.

Important Facts

- The Magnolia Park Family Resource Center provides residents with vital community and family strengthening services that include parent education and family enrichment activities; youth empowerment; mental health counseling; support groups; domestic violence intervention and prevention; access to low- and no-cost health services; and food, clothing and school supply donations. Services are provided in English, Spanish, and Vietnamese.
- From July 2019 to June 2020, the Magnolia Park Family Resource Center served 2,000 individuals. Approximately 45% of those served were provided basic needs, such as food, hygiene products, diapers, and utility and rental assistance. The need for necessities grew exponentially as families experienced loss of employment and unpredicted hardships due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- In commemoration of its 21st anniversary, the City of Garden Grove has installed a mosaic at the center's front entrance. The Magnolia Park Family Resource Center's youth group, SOL, helped create the mosaic by adding unique symbolism in the leaves' patterns. Each leaf is detailed with a word that describes the community's culture.
