JARDIN DE LOS NIÑOS

Jardín de los Niños Park is located in the Buena Clinton neighborhood on Keel Avenue, adjacent to a greenbelt that extends along the street. The park features a new colorful, garden-themed playground with a poured-in-place rubber safety surface designed to provide a safe and engaging play environment for children. Funding for the project was provided in part through a Community Project Fund Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).



WOODBURY PARK

Woodbury Park is located at 13800 Rosita Place. In December 2021, the City of Garden Grove Community Services Department was awarded a \$6 million grant from the California Department of Parks and Recreation to help fund the revitalization and expansion of the park. The project includes a complete renovation and expansion of the existing park, with improvements designed through an extensive community engagement process that incorporated input from neighborhood residents. The revitalized park includes a new walking trail, outdoor fitness equipment, a recreational swimming pool, two playground areas, picnic shelters, a skate plaza, basketball courts, enhanced park lighting, security cameras, new park restrooms, and parking lot. These improvements create a vibrant, accessible community destination that promotes recreation, health, and neighborhood gathering for residents of all ages.

These park improvements support the priorities identified in the City's Parks and Facilities Master Plan, enhancing recreational opportunities for neighborhood families.
