### Safe City

This program promotes safe routes to school while educating children on traffic safety. A Crime Prevention Officer will walk children through a mini city, point out traffic hazards, and provide tips on how to navigate safely.

### Bike/Pedestrian Safety

A Crime Prevention Officer will speak about safety on wheels, the use of properly fitted helmets, as well as pedestrian traffic safety.

### **Traffic Safety**

This is a traffic safety class designed specifically for kids. A Crime Prevention Officer will discuss everyday hazards and recommend top safety tips. Youths will play the "What If" game to review best practices for traffic and pedestrian safety.

### **Car Seat Safety**

A certified Car Seat Technician will discuss car seat laws with you and your child. One-on-one car seat inspections are offered by appointment only.

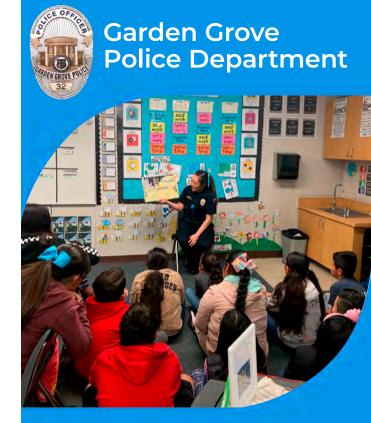

# Community Liaison Division Programs

The mission of the Community Liaison Division is to build a partnership between the police department and our residents to improve the quality and safety of our community. In order to achieve this, we offer numerous programs to engage community members in learning safety tips and strategies.



### Overview of Programs

We collaborate with our community members, neighborhoods, schools, and organizations to offer a variety of educational programs. These programs are continually reviewed and modified for age appropriateness.

# Summaries of Programs

### Anti-Bullying

The effects of bullying are discussed and examined. Students learn how to be a positive leader by taking a stand against bullying. Parents will learn techniques on how to address bullying with their children.

### **Internet Safety**

This program is for children and parents to discuss proper use as well as the dangers of the Internet and online services.

### Substance Abuse

This program will identify, examine, and discuss the effects of substance and drug abuse in our community.

## Choices and Delinquent Activity

This program reviews the process of decision-making and why individual choices are important to us all. Risky behaviors, gang prevention, and other delinquent activities will be discussed.

### **Personal Safety**

This program is designed to discuss and share tips on how to keep you and your family safe. This program is appropriate for individuals, whether at home or in the workplace.

### Police Department Tours

Guests have an opportunity to tour our police department and learn how the different units work together to help keep our community safe.

### Citizen Academy

This is an annual program where our residents, community members, and business owners can learn about the Police Department's daily operations and services.

### Neighborhood Watch

Come meet your neighbors, Beat Officer, and Crime Prevention Officer to discuss how to keep your family and neighborhood safe.

### Junior Neighborhood Watch

This program enables officers and youth to develop a positive relationship, while encouraging youth to take an active approach in their community.

### Officer Friendly

A Crime Prevention Officer will talk with children about the duties of a Police Officer. This program will teach kids that officers are community helpers they can trust.

### **Child Safety**

This program teaches children to recognize danger signs and how to react safely in an age appropriate way. Topics of discussion include protecting and strengthening personal space, identifying dangers, and safety tips to practice daily.
