What is an IEP clinic?

- IEP clinics provide families an opportunity to meet with a Family Support Specialist from TASK to review and address specific questions related to their child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).
- The IEP clinics are scheduled in one hour increments so the focus can be on one or two of your most important issues related to your child's educational needs.
- IEP clinics are designed to provide individual assistance to families who need help understanding a child's IEP and plan strategies for the IEP meeting. You must provide your child's most recent IEP prior to appointment for review.
