The fundamental responsibility of the City of Garden Grove is to protect **all** of its residents and maintain public safety.

If a person, regardless of their immigration status, commits a violent or serious offense against members of our community, we will enforce all applicable laws to protect our community. Chief Tom DaRé added, "Community partnerships and community trust are vital to our mission and we strive to make Garden Grove a safe and inclusive place for everyone."
