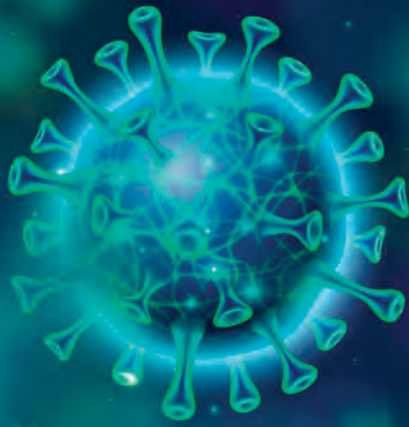

DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

ALL CITY EVENTS, CLASSES, AND PROGRAMS LISTED WITHIN THIS BROCHURE ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

The City of Garden Grove continues to take steps to flatten the curve. According to Stage 3 State and County guidelines, the following park amenities remain closed: basketball courts, fitness equipment, Garden Grove Sports and Recreation Center, park buildings (West Grove & West Haven), picnic shelters, and playgrounds. Team sport games (basketball, baseball, softball, volleyball, etc.) are not allowed in the parks.

Passive recreation including exercising, jogging, and walking is welcome in the parks. In addition, patrons may once again enjoy the following re-opened amenities: athletic fields for practice (no games) by permit only, dog park, skate spot, racquetball courts, and tennis courts.

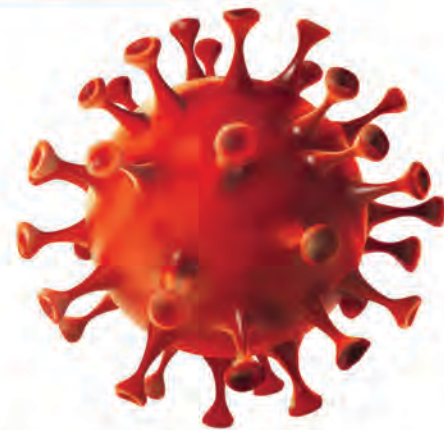

AQUATICS PROGRAM

Please thoroughly read this entire section before registering for classes. We have made many changes to the aquatics program this year.

The 2020 Summer Aquatics Program offers swimming lessons at two of our pool locations. Magnolia Park Pool will be closed this season.

Pools will open for swim lessons on Monday, July 6. Pool rentals and recreational swimming will be discontinued until further notice. For more information about the summer program, call (714) 741-5200.

COVID-19 ADJUSTED PROGRAM

During this unprecedented time, due to the current pandemic, the City of Garden Grove is modifying the aquatics program to preserve the safety of our patrons and staff. We maintain that water safety is essential to the well-being of the children of our community. In order to provide an effective program, we are modifying our program as follows:

- **No contact lessons** - Instructors will teach from the poolside. (All pre-school, Guppy, and Seal levels will require a parent in the water with their child.)
- **Smaller class sizes** - Up to five children maximum.
- **Distanced learning** - Classes will be modified to allow 6 ft. of space between students.
- **Sanitizing** - All commonly used surfaces and objects will be sanitized between lessons.
- **Patron limitations** - Only swim participants and one parent/guardian will be allowed on the pool deck.
- **Arrive on-time, ready to swim, and leave promptly after the lesson has finished** - Students must arrive in their swimsuit, ready to swim, and no one will be permitted to linger on the pool deck before or after class.
- **Wellness checks** - Parents are encouraged to check in with themselves and their children before leaving the house to attend swim lessons. Please stay home if you or your children have a fever (100.4 degrees or higher), a persistent cough, or shortness of breath. We will also be conducting verbal wellness checks with our patrons prior to entering the pool deck.

SWIM LESSONS

American Red Cross swimming lessons emphasize the development of swimming skills to promote personal safety, exercise, and social interaction (at a distance).

Our swim classes are suitable for children ages 3-15. We also offer private lessons suitable for all ages.

Swim classes consist of eight 40-minute lessons, Monday through Thursday, for two weeks.

- General group lessons are \$60 per student.
- Private lessons start at \$200.

Fees are payable at the time of registration. Major credit cards are accepted. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, in-person class registrations will **NOT** be available at pool sites.

Online registration will be conducted on a first come, first served basis as class capacity allows.

NOTE: All programs, classes and fees are subject to change or cancellation without notice. Should a participant wish to cancel or change a class after the registration process, there will be a \$5 processing fee per class. **Refund requests** must be made **one week prior** to the start of the first class or program. Class changes or transfers may only be accommodated if space allows and **will not be permitted once the class has begun**. Please be absolutely sure you register your child in the appropriate class for their swim ability. Due to the impact of Covid-19 on our program, we will not be able to accommodate class transfers due to mistakes in registration. Your child will be asked to leave the first day of class if they are not enrolled in the correct level. **Refunds will not be offered for mis-registrations** within a week prior to the class start date.

NO CONTACT SWIM CLASS DESCRIPTIONS (All group classes are \$60)

We believe smaller class sizes and parent/guardian (16 years of age or older) assistance will allow for lessons that are better tailored to each student's needs, and will allow for more individual practice time. This year we encourage patrons to bring their own toys, kickboards, and goggle to use during lessons.

Preschool Swim Class (Ages 3-5 ONLY)

This season our preschool classes require parent participation.

Parents are required to be in the water with their student for the preschool level. If the parent is not ready to be in the water with their child on the first day of class, they will be asked to leave and return prepared the next day.

This class is for all children ages 3-5, whether your child has no swim experience, or they are swimming almost independently.

In preschool level, your child will learn or improve swimming fundamentals such as breath control, front and back floats, gliding, and arm and leg mechanics for the front and back crawl. In preschool classes we also think it's important for young children to have fun while learning, so you will sing songs, play games, have toy time, and expand your imagination.

Swim Classes

Please be absolutely sure you register your child in the appropriate class for their level.

Due to the impact of Covid-19 on our program, we will not be able to accommodate class transfers due to mistakes in registration. Your child will be asked to leave the first day of class if they are not enrolled in the correct level. Refunds will not be offered for mis-registrations within a week prior to the class start date.

Ages: 6-15

Guppy (Level 1): Parent participation is required for this level.

Parents are required to be in the water with their student for Guppy level. If the parent is not ready to be in the water with their child on the first day of class, they will be asked to leave and return prepared the next day. Some students may qualify to swim without a parent **after an instructor evaluation.**

This class is for new swimmers ages 6-15. Guppy class introduces swimming and water safety to children with little or no previous swimming experience. This level helps children build confidence, swim on front and back short distances by themselves, and develop safety skills in and around the water.



Seal (Level 2): Parent participation is required for this level.

Parents are required to be in the water with their student for Seal level. If the parent is not ready to be in the water with their child on the first day of class, they will be asked to leave and return prepared the next day. Some students may qualify to swim without a parent **after an instructor evaluation.**

For children 6-15 who have **passed** the Guppy Level

This class is for children who can swim more than 15 feet by themselves on their front and back. New skills include side breathing, treading water, and water safety skills.

Dolphin (Level 3)

For children 7-15 who have **passed** the Seal Level or who are able to swim 15 yards (45 ft.) completely unassisted in front and backstroke, jump into deep water, and tread water. New skills include introduction and development of elementary backstroke and breaststroke, dolphin, and sidestroke kicks.

Barracuda (Level 4)

For children 7-15 who have **passed** the Dolphin Level or who are able to swim 25 yards completely unassisted in front and backstroke, and 15 yards of breaststroke kick and dolphin kick. This level focuses on stroke improvement and building endurance and versatility in the water. New skills include introduction and development of the breaststroke, butterfly stroke and flip turns.

Adult Learn to Swim Lessons • Ages: 16+

For adults and young adults who wish to learn the fundamentals or improve their basic skills.

Private Lessons • All Ages

Individual instruction for all ages is available in a series of eight (8) lessons, 40 minutes in length. Participants enrolled in semi-private lessons will occupy the same lane, and must be from the same household.

In-water parent participation is required for all children under 7, and children of all ages who swim at the Guppy or Seal level. Some students may qualify to swim without a parent after an instructor evaluation. If the parent is not ready to be in the water with their child on the first day of class, they will be asked to leave and return prepared the next day.

- Private for one is \$200
- Semi-private for two is \$280
- Semi-private for three is \$350

How to Register:

1. Go to our website,
www.ggcity.org/AquaticsRegistration
2. Select "Summer Aquatics" and scroll until you find the level and class time **at your desired pool location.**
3. Select the blue "Add" button to add a class to your registration cart.
4. If you have not logged in, you will be redirected to log in to your ReGGister account or to create an account.
5. To create an account, first provide the information **for the registering adult** and then proceed to add your child* to your account. Be sure to mark their role as a student at the top of the page.
6. Continue to register for classes* or check out with your cart.

*When registering multiple children, be sure to mark the correct child with the correct course level.

If you would like to register for a semi-private:

1. All students must be from the same household.
2. Choose only one student to enroll in a private lesson.
3. Contact a pool manager to add remaining students. Call (714) 741-5200 during City Hall opening hours.

- Current mortgage statement/lease agreement
- Property tax statement

In addition:

- Children may only be registered by a parent(s) or legal guardian(s)
- Must bring child's birth certificate
- Payment is required at time of registration
- No phone-in or mail-in registration will be accepted
