## Swim Lessons

The City of Garden Grove Aquatics program offers American Red Cross swimming lessons taught by ARC certified instructors. ARC water safety lessons emphasize the development of swimming skills to promote personal safety, exercise, and social interaction.

Our group swim classes are suitable for children ages 3-15. We also offer private lessons suitable for all ages.

Group and private lessons are available in a series of eight (8) lessons, 40 minutes in length. Monday through Thursday for two weeks at a time.

Our summer program consists of five, two week long sessions. Our summer program corresponds to the GGUSD summer break.
