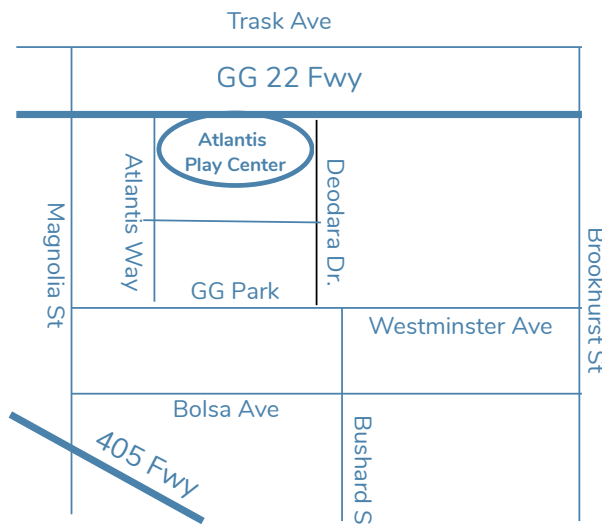

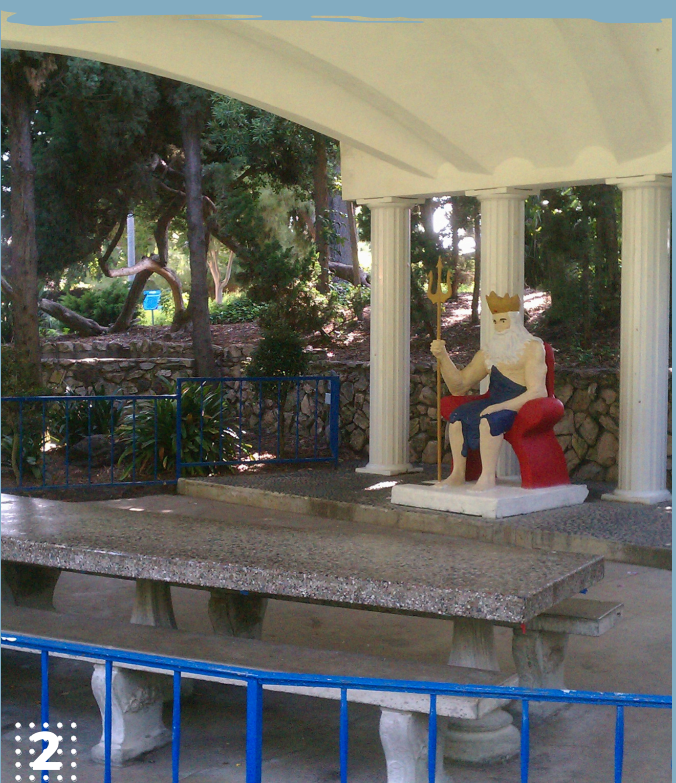
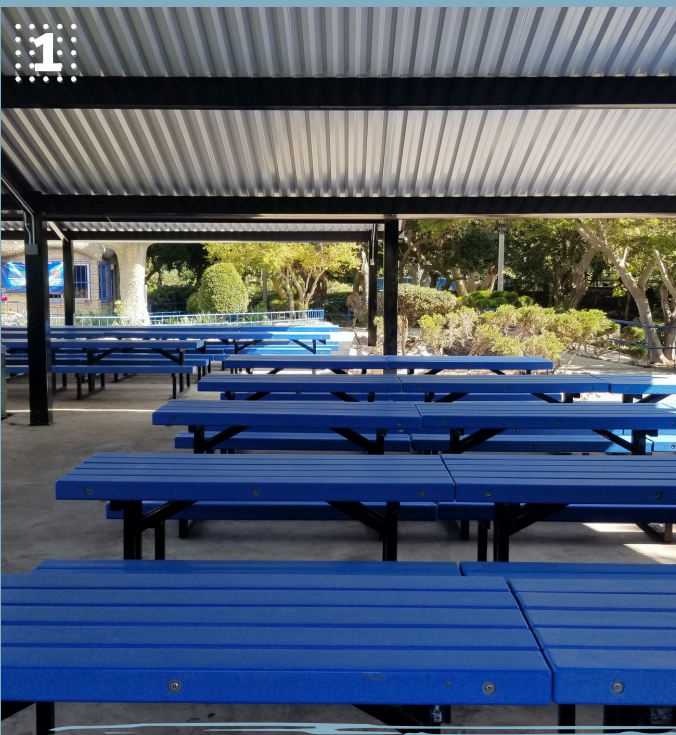

#1 | PICNIC TABLE RESERVATIONS

\$ 5.00/table

- Max 12 tables per day
- Does not include park entrance fee

#2 | KING NEPTUNE'S PAVILION

\$25.00/45 min.

- Includes exclusive use of the pavilion
- Capacity up to 30 guests
- Does not include park entrance fee

Reservations can be made up to **two (2) months in advance & no later than (1) one week prior** by calling the **Community Services Department** at **(714) 741-5200**.

GENERAL ADMISSION

- \$2 per person entrance fee
- Free for children 2 and under
- Adults must be accompanied by a child

AFTER HOURS & EXCLUSIVE RENTALS

Exclusive and after-hours rentals may be requested up to 6 months in advance. For pricing and reservations, call the Atlantis Coordinator at (714) 741-5207.

Reservations are on a first come, first serve basis up to two times per month.

PROHIBITED ITEMS
